

CLASSIFIED JOB DESCRIPTION

LEAD PLUMBER

JOB SUMMARY:

Under general supervision, acts as the lead person for the plumbing crew; performs journeyman level work installing, maintaining, and repairing sanitary plumbing pipes and fixtures, air, oil, gas pipes, and heating systems; and performs other duties as assigned.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Performs as a skilled working lead, modeling and assisting others by example.
- Directs the workflow of other less experienced employees.
- Installs, maintains, and repairs sanitary plumbing, pipes, and fixtures, i.e. faucets, drinking fountains, boilers, copper and galvanized pipes, toilets, sinks, and water and gas lines.
- Threads and bends copper and galvanized pipes.
- Tests joints and pipe systems for leaks.
- Cleans drains.
- Transports self, materials, and tools.
- Estimates cost of materials and labor.
- Purchases parts, chemicals, tools, and other supplies.
- Coordinates job requests and scheduling of work orders.
- Analyzes/designs and assigns repair and installation from work order requests and projects.
- Inspects completed work and new installations.
- Reads and Interprets blueprints, schematics, and specifications.
- Performs preventative maintenance on all District's plumbing systems.
- Recommends specifications, replacement, modification, installation of plumbing systems, and equipment.
- Troubleshoots and repairs sewer ejection pumps and systems.
- Prepares records and reports.
- Repairs gas kitchen equipment.

ESSENTIAL JOB REQUIREMENTS - QUALIFICATIONS:

- At least four years recent successful experience as a journeyman or two years successful experience within the District.
- Ability to read blueprints, estimate time, and material for job orders; ability to train and direct efforts of others effectively; maintain cooperative relationships with those contacted in the course of work; and communicate and interact effectively and professionally under pressure. Must be licensed to drive a light truck or van to and from jobs.
- Knowledge of methods, tools, equipment, materials, and means of transportation for the particular journeyman tasks.
- High school diploma or GED required.

- Graduation from a recognized trade school, or completion of equivalent training and experience.
- Must possess a valid California driver's license. Must have a good driving record. Must be insurable under the District's insurance program and must maintain insurability.
- Must be willing to carry a pager and respond to off-hour calls. Must be willing to be trained and certified for asbestos inspection and removal. May be required to work weekends.
