Course Subject	Course Name	Course Description
Science Enrichment (K-4)	The Wonder Lab	Are you a scientist at heart? Dive into the deep questions around why and how things work and how they play out in our daily lives! We will be exploring chemistry (chemical reactions), physics (forces and motion, gravity, and energy), life science (traits and adaptations), and earth science (our wild weather). Come ready to conduct an experiment each week and participate in hands-on projects and simulations. A fully integrated science and language experience!
Elementary Art Enrichment (K-5)	Amazing Artists	Do you love art? Find your inner artist through two-dimensional and three-dimensional art projects. Each Amazing Artist will use a variety of art techniques and media to create unique pieces of art. We will try our hand at a variety of different types of art including drawing, sculpture, paper mache, and many more! Everyone can be an artist! Come join us for a time of imagination and creativity, and be prepared to get messy!
Social Studies Enrichment (K-5)	Road Trip Through Time	Adventure through the United States, past and present! As we travel state by state, we will learn about important landmarks, important people and events, and the geography of the 50 states. Prepare yourself to “live” in Colonial Boston during the Revolutionary War, create a product for a state market, and explore Washington State over time, among other history mysteries. Expect hands-on classroom experiences and fun projects. This integrated class will have students reading, writing, and improving their geography skills as they travel across the USA with an eye on the present and the past! This class will integrate social studies content with reading, writing, and art.
ELA Enrichment (2-4)	Inventors Ink: Read, Imagine, and Invent!	If you love to read, invent, and learn about how things work, this class is for you! We will explore some of the world’s most famous inventors and inventions and how they work. Expect to explore nonfiction books and articles, fiction picture books, and chapter books as we explore the wild world of inventors and inventions. Themes include transportation, toy making, space, and music to name a few! During class time, not only will you learn and create amazing inventions, but have time to write and create books about your own inventions and ideas.
Adventurers (K-8)	Adventurers	Calling all adventurers! This K-8 class will be full of exploration. Each month, we will have a theme and a field trip that supports our learning. A list of field trips for the first semester will be released at the start of the school year. We will be meeting at HomeLink two Fridays each month, and adventuring out into the world at least one Friday a month. Field trip days may extend beyond hours on the schedule and parents provide transportation for their child. We will explore our monthly theme in class prior to the field trip as well as at home through research, projects, and writing. Then, we will get to have a hands-on,

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		out-of-the-classroom experience. There will be a fee each semester to participate in this class.
Science Enrichment (5-8)	Fur Real Science: Exploring the Animal Kingdom	Explore the science behind the amazing animal kingdom! Learn about animal adaptations, behaviors, and their place in the world. In this class we will explore animals and the world around them! We will incorporate hands-on elements to this class, as well as experiments that relate to subject matter that is being covered.
Middle School Art Enrichment (6-8)	From Togas to Trends: A Journey Through Fashion	In this class, you'll learn about history that you can WEAR! Learn to sew, work with leather and do cool fiber projects like turning wool into yarn and learning how to weave. We'll be time traveling from early civilizations to modern day and discovering what different people, like soldiers, wore in different time periods, as well as looking at the clothing of the royalty and why those things were popular or important. We are going to make some awesome outfits and gear that you can take home!
US History Enrichment (6-8)	Unpacking the Past: A Thematic Journey Through U.S. History	In this class we will explore U.S. history through themes and major benchmarks from the past to present. The goal is to unpack key concepts that show up throughout history and identify the trends that express themselves over time. This helps students to analyze these moments in history and stimulate discussion and critical thinking about events.
ELA Novels Enrichment (5-8)	Words and Wilderness Class	Unleash your inner adventurer! In this class, we'll journey through the survival stories of <i>My Side of the Mountain</i> and <i>Hatchet</i> , uncovering the incredible resilience of young people in the wilderness. Beyond the books, we'll equip you with real-world survival skills: compass navigation, DIY water filtration, and practical foraging. Discover the thrilling overlap between fiction and the fundamental ability to thrive with what nature provides. Get ready to read, write, and learn to survive!
Cinematography (6-8)	Movie Making 101	In this course we will try our hands at different kinds of film such as documentaries, movies, commercials and animated clips. We will be our own casts and this class will rely heavily on teamwork and collaboration, as we learn about different styles of cinematography. This course will teach students technical skills like film editing as well as filming for themselves. Come with me as we take our theater skills to the screen, and we are creative and collaborative together!
