



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will I receive the results of the PreK Screening?

The PreK teachers will analyze the results of all screenings conducted to determine eligibility. Children may be offered a spot with our current preschool classroom or placed on a waiting list. Results of the screening and notification on whether or not you have received clearance to move forward with the registration process will be shared with caregivers within two weeks by a member of the team.

NOTE: If the team believes that your child would benefit from an additional early intervention play-based assessment, the district case manager will contact you. This type of evaluation assesses a child's skills to determine if they have a developmental delay or disability and are eligible for early intervention services.

What are the school uniform requirements?

Tops	Correctly sized white or light blue button down or polo shirts. Short or long sleeve with collar. (NO T-Shirts) - SHIRTS MUST BE TUCKED IN.
Bottoms	Navy blue or black uniform pants or shorts. (No blue jeans) - NO SAGGING
Shoes	Black or blue shoes.
Belts	Black or blue.
Sweaters	White or navy blue, button down or pull-over sweaters or blazers. NO HOODIES

Is transportation provided?

PreK students **who reside within district boundaries** will receive transportation. After completing the entire registration process, you MUST send an email to transport@sd1525.org to arrange for complimentary door-to-door transportation for your PreK student.

Once the District receives your email requesting transportation, the District will set up transportation for your student(s). The District will send you an email to confirm the door-to-door schedule for your student(s). Please include a valid telephone number in the email that you send so that we can reach you directly as needed.

How can consistent school attendance support my child's growth and development during their early years?

As your child begins school, it is important to remember that **early childhood is a critical time for growth and development**, and **consistent attendance** plays a key role in ensuring that your child receives the full benefits of our curriculum. Each day in Pre-K is packed with activities that foster social, emotional, cognitive, and physical development. **Missing school can lead to gaps in learning and make it harder for your child to connect with their peers, engage with the lessons, and build the foundational skills they will need for kindergarten and beyond.**
