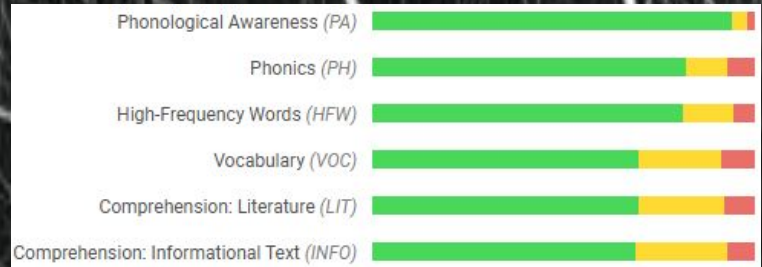

Reading - May 2024

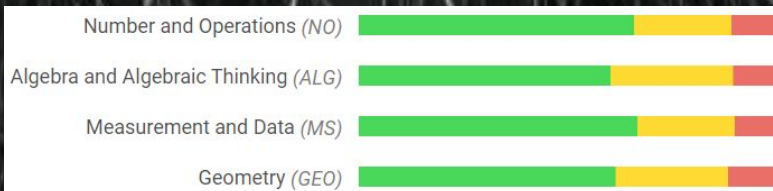
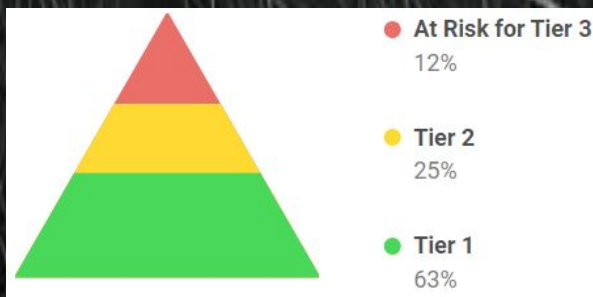


Reading - May 2025

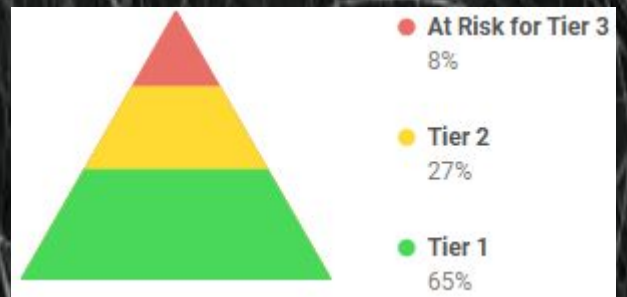


Mathematics - May 2024

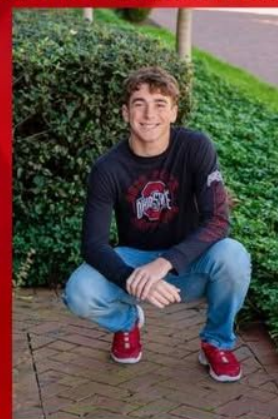
