Recap of April BOE

- The purpose of BIGG is to create a set of goals that will focus the work of the Board of Education. These goals will serve as a means by which we make our expectations of our administration and ourselves clear. We will monitor our progress on meeting these goals.
- The Board voted to adopt the BIGG Workplan

Phases

The BIGG Workplan outlined three phases of activities.

- Phase One: introduce and adopt work plan
- Phase Two: Conduct first wave of engagement and outreach; draft preliminary goals
- Phase Three: conduct final wave of engagement and outreach; adopt final goals in resolution format

Shortfalls

We fell short of our intended engagement sessions for the Summer.

We produced a survey that went out later than intended and was formatted in a confusing manner.

We intended to provide draft goals for community consideration today, but need to push that out to next month.

Draft Goals

We are beginning to draft goals based on our engagement sessions and survey responses. We still intend to finalize these draft goals and share them for community consideration. We will use additional feedback to determine if the goals should be edited or changed prior to adoption later this year.

While we cannot share specific drafts, we are ready to share the topics that we believe our initial draft goals will attempt to address.
