- **Facility Update** : SRFACS 7th and 8th graders will begin attending Montgomery High School in the 2025/26 school year, creating a 7-12 school. We are hoping to grow our 7th grade. TK - 6th grade will move to our new campus (SRMS location) in the 2026/27 school year. On 2/24/2025, Lisa August and Vicki Zands (from the district) met with Evelyn Anderson to discuss the facility at SRMS. Capacity is +/- 780, which will provide positive growth for SRFACS. Evelyn will create and share a Google doc for people to share questions, concerns, and assumptions regarding all the school updates/changes.
