Stop by and join the Edina Art Center, Edina Fire Department and Edina Police Officers at the Park and Make Art Together. New art activity will be available each month.

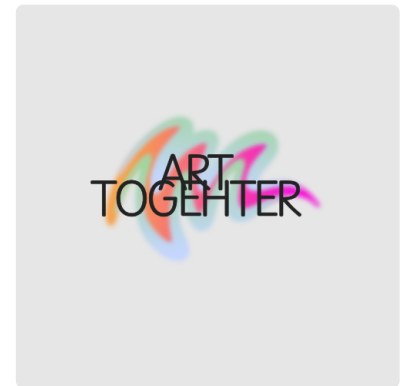

Energy Assistance- Applications Due May 31

Applications for Energy Assistance are now available. Renters and home owners who are needing assistance paying their energy bills

(gas, electric) can complete an application between October 1, 2024 and May 31, 2025. Eligible applicants may receive a grant paid directly to their utility provider to reduce utility expenses.

Summer EBT is now SUN BUCKS

SUN Bucks is an income-based food support program that provides families with \$120 per eligible school-aged child to buy groceries when school is out for the summer. Most eligible children are automatically enrolled. Auto-enrollment programs include: MFIP, SNAP, TANF, MA with income guidelines at or below 185% of poverty, Approved Educational Benefits for SY 2024-25.



If you will not be auto enrolled, complete the **2024-25 Educational Benefits Application** with your school district. You will be notified by your school district if you are eligible.

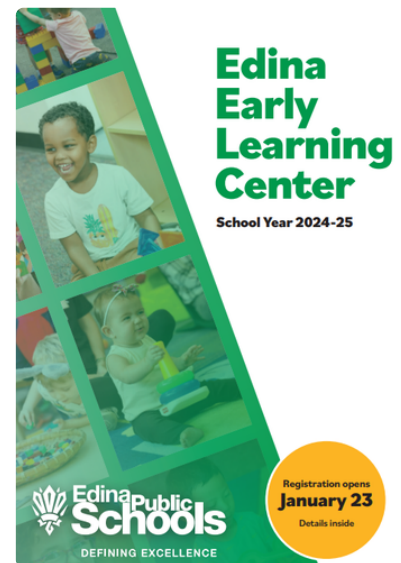
