

Games to Play in the Car

or in line at the store

Any chance you have to spend with your child is a chance for them to learn. These simple games will help your child to learn and keep them busy and entertained.

- Guess what letter I am thinking of? (Make the sound of a letter and let the student tell you what letter goes with that sound.)
- Count the words. (Say a sentence slowly. Ask the student to tell you how many words were in the sentence.)
- **Silly Rhymes** (Tell a rhyme or sing a song that your child knows well. Change one word in the rhyme and see if they can find the mistake. eg. Humpty Dumpty sat on a car.)
- Do you hear what I hear? (Ask the student to close their eyes and identify sounds they hear around them. Horns honking, birds chirping, cash registers clicking, etc.)
- **Rhyming Words** (Say a word that has lots of rhyming partners. eg. cat Ask your child to think of all the words they can that rhyme with "cat." They will need help at first.)
