With new topics to learn about, various class trips and visits taking place, Sports Day and the summer fair, it looks to be another exciting term ahead. LEARNING SNAPSHOTS

Year 1: Year One have really enjoyed looking at Art by James Rizzi in their 'Street View' topic. The children have been learning about form and enjoyed making a colourful, 3D street view picture. To make the picture 3D they layered cardboard underneath the different parts, experimenting with making some parts stick out further than others.

Ask me: how do I make a 3D picture?







Year 2: This week year 2 have continued to learn about telling the time, they have practised reading times on the clock and drawing the minute and hour hands on them. They have also played 'Magnificent Monarch' board games and drawn together their knowledge and understanding from their history learning to have a go at creating their own board games. Year 2 have continued to enjoy their music unit linked to friendship and are really good at finding the beat and the pulse using a range of different body percussion movements.

Ask me: Which hand is the hour hand and which hand is the minute hand on a clock?



Year 3 Year 3 have been learning about mosaics this week; what they are and how they are made. They have enjoyed exploring shape, pattern and colour by designing and making their own mosaic artwork. They have been telling the time to 5 minutes and to 1 minute in their maths lessons. During French they have had fun practicing their colours and using 'please' and 'thank you'.

Year 4 had a visit from Street Smart. The Slough Youth Workers spoke to the children about keeping safe. They discussed what they would do if someone they didn't know offered them a lift in a car. In PE the children enjoyed relay races, demonstrating some excellent baton change over skills. Our second PE lesson was an orienteering session on one of the Eton playing fields. This session was run by Windsor Sports Partnership.

Ask Me: What did you learn from Street Smart?



Reception: have been finishing off their project Animal Safari by researching and learning about unusual animals. Each group chose an unusual animal they would like to find out more about, asked questions and then created a poster. We began to explore the term 'endangered' this week and spent time discussing how we can help our environment.

Ask me: what does 'endangered' mean?


