The Splash Pad is free, family-friendly fun. No matter how hot it is outside, the Splash Pad provides an entertaining way for people of all ages to keep cool. These amenities are great for younger children because they do not present the same drowning hazard as swimming pools.

A magic touch bollard turns on the fun. Interactive spray elements are timed so water only runs when the sprayground is in use. There are several water effects for all children to play in, including a raining bucket, an in-ground spray fountain, poles, a colorful misty arch, geysers, and a spray column all located on a blue rubber surface. Two benches and a beach hut shade structure provide places for adults to stay dry and supervise while children play.
