

WHAT TO BRING

ROOM SUPPLIES

- Bedding for a twin-sized bed—pillow, blanket, comforter, 2 sets of sheets and pillowcases
- Towels and washcloths
- Alarm clock
- Soft, collapsible laundry basket
- Shower basket/caddy
- Food storage containers (small and medium-sized plastic tubs with a tight-fitting lid)
- Beige masking tape for hanging artwork on walls. Beige masking tape is the only adhesive permitted - no other tape, tabs, hooks, blue putty, command strips, etc. permitted.
- Sleeping bag (for use on camping trips)
- Personal water bottle for refilling at our bottle refill stations
- Duffle bag

CLOTHES

- School clothes for regular weekdays
- Professional dress clothes for Fridays (Form 4 and above) see *Student and Parent Handbook* for details
- Rugged and warm clothing for outdoor activities
- Comfortable exercise clothes and athletic sneakers (cross trainers/running shoes with good arch support) for Physical Education classes.
- Raincoat and/or windbreaker
- Hooded parka
- Boots for rain
- Hiking boots
- Warm gloves

DEBIT OR CREDIT CARD

Please do not bring more than \$50 cash. For the security of your money, please sign up for either the Greenlight card (U.S. students only) or a debit or credit card from the bank of your choice. We have an ATM on campus should your child need extra cash at any time.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- Backpack
- Upper School Students - laptop computer
- Paper, pens, pencils, notebooks and a calculator

Plan to purchase a dictionary after arriving in order to get guidance from the teacher on an appropriate one.

Basic school supplies are available at the campus store.

PERSONAL SUPPLIES

- Bathrobe and slippers
- Shower shoes
- Soap, toothbrush, deodorant, laundry detergent, etc.
- For students who regularly use natural preventative health products such as homeopathic tablets, arnica rub, calcium & magnesium, Emergen-C and electrolyte products, bring personal supply for self use, to be kept in the student's dorm room.

Perfumes, colognes and excessively scented lotions or sprays are discouraged.

There is a small campus store in the recreation room that stocks some basic supplies.

OPTIONAL

- Musical instruments
- Laundry marker
- Bicycle, skateboard, scooter, or rollerblades and helmet and pads (see *Student and Parent Handbook* for details and requirements)
- Reading lamp
- Surge protector
- Small iron and ironing board
- Small fan or heater (heater must have an automatic shut-off feature in case it tips over or it will not pass fire safety code)
- Specialized athletic equipment and clothing (soccer cleats, ski gear, etc.)
- Small containers for organizing personal belongings on shelves

ELECTRONICS

We ask you send your child with no devices other than a phone for staying in touch.

- Wristwatch (smartwatches allowed for Upper School students only)
- Cell phone (optional: the school has phones students can use to call home)

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED

Pets

Televisions/monitors/game stations

Motorcycles, electric scooters and bicycles

Firearms, knives or dangerous weapons

Air conditioning units (window or floor models)

High wattage or cooking appliances (hot plates, rice cookers, etc.)

Room heaters without an automatic shut-off feature in place if they tip or fall over

“Command” hooks or any type of mounting/ attaching hooks for dorm rooms

LED light strips or any lights with sticky backs/ strips to attach directly to walls/other surfaces

Hazardous explosives or flammables (candles, incense, propane, etc.)

Pornography

Laser pointers

IDENTIFYING POSSESSIONS

All of a student's possessions, especially clothing, should be plainly marked with the student's name.

While the school makes every effort to care for the property of its students, it is not considered liable for any loss that may occur. Parents are urged to secure a homeowner's insurance policy which includes their child's possessions while away at school.
