

Professional Development

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- The school maintains a strong commitment to Professional Development.
- All staff members are encouraged to apply and attend the most appropriate courses, conventions, workshops, further education, etc. related to their position, organised both internally and world-wide.
- There is a Professional Development Committee
 with members representing Upper and Lower
 School faculty as well as support staff to review
 and approve the disbursement of the Professional
 Development funding. The yearly funding is 1.8%
 of the payroll costs and is guaranteed within the
 Collective Bargaining Agreement.

- Each school year two school days are completely dedicated to internal professional development.
 These two days staff members have the opportunity to participate in a wide range of different activities and workshops.
- We also support integration into the local community through funding and organising of language courses for staff members, either traditional classroom-based, one-on-one or through on-line learning platform.
