Story Voyage

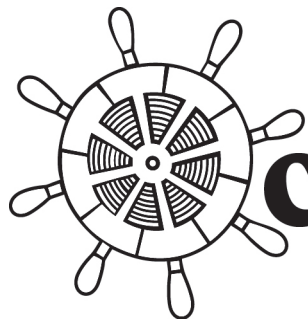
