## 2025 NHS Summer Reading Program

Dear Newmark High School Parents,

Our 2025 Summer Reading Program is designed to help students strengthen their reading comprehension skills while fostering a love for reading. Each year, students are encouraged to select a high-interest novel to make reading an enjoyable and engaging experience. Students can read as many books as they like over the summer.

**This year, all students—whether or not they are attending ESY—are required to read one book from the provided reading lists.**

- **Students attending ESY** will have the opportunity to select their book in advance. Copies of the chosen book will be available in the English classroom on the first day of ESY.
- **Students NOT attending ESY** are expected to purchase their book from a bookstore of their choice.

During the first weeks of school, students will complete a required English class assignment based on the book they read. They will choose from a variety of creative options on a choice board, including writing a diary entry, designing a collage, creating a soundtrack, compiling a book of poetry or writing a letter to the author. This assignment will be graded and count toward their first-quarter English grade.

**Please ensure your teen brings their summer reading book on the first day of school, Thursday, September 4, 2025.**
