WHEREAS, Board of Education Policy # 3411 and Policy # 7360 allow for exceptions to the general prohibitions on the possession of weapons in schools and on school district property for law enforcement officers and for individuals who have the written authorization of the Allegany-Limestone Central School District Board of Education or its designee.
NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby authorizes School Security Guard **Dan Brown**, to carry a firearm on school property while carrying out the duties of their position of School Security Guard in accordance with the School Security Guard qualifications and requirements set out by Cattaraugus County Civil Service; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent of Schools is authorized to execute any and all written authorizations required by law as related to the School Security Guard position and is directed to ensure that all requirements of law for the position are adhered to with respect to the possession of a firearm by the School Security Guard on school property; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent of Schools or his designee is further authorized to take any and all other actions as may reasonably be required in furtherance of this resolution.
