What is the Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act?

WIOA is a federally funded program that provides training and employment services at **NO- COST**

Will the WIOA program help me get a job?

The **WIOA** program offers various interactive services to help you succeed in your job search. In addition, you may qualify for intensive, customized services that provide one on one career counseling. WIOA staff are committed to provide you with strategies and techniques to help you find employment.

How do I qualify for WIOA services? You may be eligible if you are ONE of the following:

- Unemployed or Underemployed (receiving or have received Unemployment Insurance benefits)
- Veteran or Eligible Spouse
- Basic Skills Deficient or English Language Learner
- Justice-Involved Individual or Returning Resident
- Individual with a Disability
- Recipient of Public Assistance or Low-Income

Many WIOA employment services are offered to the public without needing to be in one of the groups above.

What services are offered through the WIOA program?

- Training and financial assistance
- Employment Leads
- Recruitment and Job Fairs
- Resume and Cover Letter assistance
- Job Search Workshops
- Interview Assistance
- Computer Center/use of computers
- Referrals to support services
