Drop Off and Pick Up Reminders

Please remember some of these important rules for Drop Off and Pick Up. We want to ensure the safety of all our students and staff members. Please only drop off or pick up along the sidewalk where we have staff coverage, or park in the neighborhood or the North parking lot and walk with your student.

- The North Lot is for parking and walking with your student, not a Driveline drop off or pick up spot.
- If your student needs more time (to come from ASH, to get FroYo, etc), please help the flow of traffic by not waiting in the car line, but either parking or circling around the Driveline again.
- If staff ask you to drive around again, please be respectful and follow their instructions.
- No smoking or dogs on campus.
- No phones while in Driveline.
- Students who are approved to be dismissed as "Walkers" can be picked up off site
 only, not in random areas on campus.
- The turf field and playground are for Leopard Care use after school. Please respect their space by taking your children off campus to play after school.


