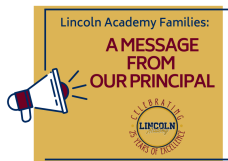

	<p>How Cold is Too Cold to Go Outside? Students are outside for recess unless the temperature falls below 22 degrees (21 degrees or below), according to our school weather station Weatherbug. You may consider downloading the WeatherBug app so you can check the latest conditions at our school in real-time.</p>

As quoted on page 12 in our [Lincoln Academy Family Handbook](#): “Please send students dressed appropriately for the weather. Students will go outside on cold days, so please send your child prepared for these conditions. Students remain outside unless the temperature goes below 22 degrees, there is excessive precipitation or extreme heat.”

Lincoln Academy will close if weather-related conditions close Jefferson County Public Schools. Jeffco may choose to do remote learning during inclement weather. Lincoln is not set up for remote learning, so we would have no school on those days.

In addition to the Jeffco automated phone calls regarding weather closures, notifications will be broadcast over the radio (KOA 850) and major local television stations ABC, CBS, and NBC. Lincoln will also send out our own communications via email and phone calls. Updates will be [posted on our website](#) as well.

If there is a call for a 2 Hour Delay due to weather, there will be no breakfast served at school. We will only do our regular lunch service on delayed start days. There will also be no Leopard Care in the mornings if there is a 2 Hour Delay, but there will be Leopard Care in the afternoon on those days.

Student Benefits Application

Although breakfast and lunch are now free for all, all families are strongly encouraged to complete a [Student Benefits Application](#) through Jeffco. This application, formerly known as ‘free and reduced’ or ‘meal application’ plays a critical role in determining many benefits for your student. If approved, the Student Benefit Application may allow waived school-related fees and field trip costs. By completing the application, you may also help Lincoln Academy secure additional state and federal funding, which can be used for supplemental literacy and math resources, hiring additional staff based on the school’s needs, and professional development and training for staff.

Families must submit a new Student Benefits Application every year. Please go to SchoolCafe.com to sign in to your account or [create a new account](#). Once logged in, select “Apply for Benefits” and it will take you from there! 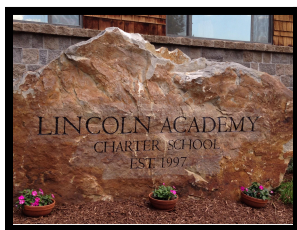
