
### **School Information**

# Leadership Roles for 2025-2026 School Year

PTO is looking to fill some leadership roles for the next school year. If you're excited about getting more involved, please check out the following positions on Track It Forward:

Community Night Organizer (we want two people in this role): One volunteer is interested in taking on the summer planning for Community Night Organizer but we'd love to find another volunteer who could be the liaison between the restaurant and the school before each monthly event. You'd touch base with the restaurant and make sure all the information and/or flyer is distributed with the front office and PTO. You'll also make sure payment is sent to the school after each event. Watch DOGS leads (we have one new lead but would love a second person to partner with him): approx 1-2 hr per month, depending on number of volunteers. This volunteer serves as a contact for anyone who signs up for Watch DOGS; coordinates volunteers with the front office; helps lead a kick-off meeting in September; and emails

Watch DOGS volunteers when the school has specific needs (Grandparents' Day, Fall Fest, shoveling, etc.)

**Treasurer (we want two people in this position):** One volunteer is interested in taking half of the tasks for the Co-Treasurer role for the PTO Board, but we would love to find another volunteer who could help with the following tasks:

Be the cash handler:

- 1) Make froyo cash deposits weekly
- 2) Handle reimbursements for staff, PTO board, & volunteers, monthly or as needed
- 3) Oversee mini grant purchasing for staff 2x a year
- 4) Check deposits

Both Co-Treasurers would be involved in setting the budget at the beginning of the term (July) with the PTO president/Board and with filing taxes and making sure our nonprofit forms are filed. A Co-Treasurer also takes part in PTO meetings and programming. (Current Treasurer will assist the new Treasurers as a guide and resource during the following school year. It is best to consider this a two-year commitment so that the first year's learning pays off!)
