Rockies Lincoln Academy Community Night

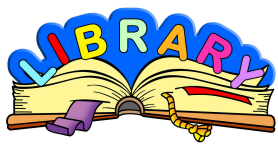

Clubs at Lincoln

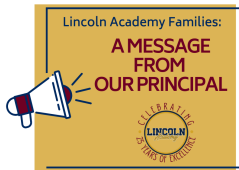

Athletic Director Position Open

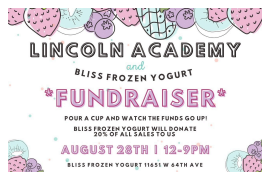

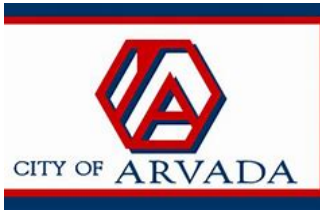
Track It Forward Volunteer Log

72nd Ave Construction Update



Road Construction Update from the City of Arvada

The speed limit on W 72nd Avenue is 25 mph, corridor-wide. Please obey the posted speed limit signs when traveling through the active construction zone.

The City is replacing a sewer trunk line along Simms St and through Davis Lane Park. There will be a single lane of alternating one way traffic on Simms between 68th and 71st avenues.

- Alternating, one way traffic will be in place 24/7.
- Work hours are anticipated to be 7am - 7pm to complete the work as quickly as possible.
- Work is expected to last through early September.
- Extended travel times are possible.

The city will also be working on our northwest corner of 72nd and Oak. We expect minimal impact on our campus and traffic, but we will keep you updated.
