Back-to-School Information



2024-2025 Registration

Many families have not completed both steps of Registration. Please make sure that you have completed both steps for all students in your household.

Step 1: Infinite Campus

- Once logged in, select "More" from the menu and then "Annual Update Online Registration"
- Click here for help with your Infinite Campus username or password
- While on Infinite Campus, click on "More" to complete the Student Benefits Application and pay student fees
 - While lunches are free for all students again this year, the Student Benefits Application is still important for school funding and financial assistance

Step 2: <u>Lincoln Academy's Online Registration</u>

Please ensure you review and agree to the <u>Technology Acceptable Use Policy Agreement Form</u> included in this link. One agreement is needed for each student prior to them using Lincoln Academy Technology. This is a requirement for each student for registration.



Arrival and Dismissal

At 7:35 am, students wanting breakfast can enter through the blue roof doors by the turf field. Staff will be there to help them in the Student Center. After eating, students will be asked to head to the normal entry door for their grade level. Any students coming to class late (after 8:00 am) from breakfast will be marked tardy.

Doors open for K-4th grade students at 7:40 am for a soft start. 5th-8th grade doors open at 7:50 am. Students will enter through these doors when they arrive:

- K-1st: South door of building B
- 2nd-4th: West door outside the main office (near the ALP room)
- 5th/6th: West building C doors
- 7th/8th: East doors outside, behind the gym

As a reminder, the north parking lot is not a drive thru/drop off area. For the safety of our students, this area is intended only for parking and walking your student to or from the sidewalk.

All of our doors are Hug and Go zones as well. Parents are not allowed in the building during arrival. We want to give teachers the chance to welcome their students and start their days with minimal distractions. We appreciate your support with these guidelines.

Dismissal

Dismissal starts at 3 pm for grades K-4 and 3:15 pm for grades 5-8. We ask that families with any 5th-8th grade students not arrive on campus for pick up until 3:15 pm; if you have younger students, they will wait safely in their classroom until you arrive.

K-4th grade students will be dismissed from the classroom. 5th-8th grade students will be escorted to the front sidewalk for dismissal. All returning students have the same driveline number as last year. Your driveline number is unique to each family and tells teachers when they can dismiss each student. Please share your number only with those who are allowed to pick up your student(s). Please visit the front office if you need a hard copy of your Driveline number.

Students Walking for Dismissal

Students may be released to walk off campus at dismissal only with guardian permission. Parents need to <u>complete this form</u> to give their permission for their student this year. **If** you completed the form last year, you will need to submit a new request again this year. Walkers may not be left unsupervised after school on the playground. All walkers are expected to walk off campus as soon as they are dismissed.

School Meals

Students in Jeffco, including at Lincoln Academy, have access to healthy and nutritious meals at no cost, regardless of their income eligibility. Breakfast and lunch will be provided at Lincoln this year. A la carte items will be available for purchase, and money can be added to student accounts using School Café.

Despite meals being served at no cost for all students, families are strongly encouraged to complete a <u>Student Benefits Application</u> on School Café. Completing this application is one of the ways to be considered eligible for other potential benefits the district may offer (i.e. field trips and fee waivers). This also helps Lincoln Academy with further funding

opportunities.

How Students will Order a Hot Lunch

Students will let their teacher know at the beginning of the day if they are choosing an item from the menu. <u>Click here</u> for menus, to add spending money to your child's account, and to make any purchase restrictions. <u>Purchase restrictions do not carry over from year to year, so make sure to log back in and reset your restrictions this year.</u>



Attendance at Lincoln

Good attendance is a very important piece of education and we love seeing our students here every day. We understand though that illness arise and dentist appointments need to happen. When these circumstances arise, there is a new way to notify our school of your student's absence. You can now submit an absence excuse via Infinite Campus Parent Portal. Our attendance line (303-467-5363 x1) still works as well, so feel free to continue calling in the absences if you want.

For planned absences, such as a family trip or fun event, we still require a pre-arranged absence form, found here on our website or in hard copy form at the front office. These absences will not be excused unless the form is completed and returned to the front office.


Rockies Lincoln Academy Community Night

72nd Ave Construction Update



Road Construction Update from the City of Arvada

The speed limit on W 72nd Avenue is 25 mph, corridor-wide. Please obey the posted speed limit signs when traveling through the active construction zone.

The City is replacing a sewer trunk line along Simms St and through Davis Lane Park. There will be a single lane of alternating one way traffic on Simms between 68th and 71st avenues.

- Alternating, one way traffic will be in place 24/7.
- Work hours are anticipated to be 7am 7pm to complete the work as quickly as possible.
- Work is expected to last through early September.
- Extended travel times are possible.

The city will also be working on our northwest corner of 72nd and Oak starting next week. We expect minimal impact on our campus and traffic, but we will keep you updated.
