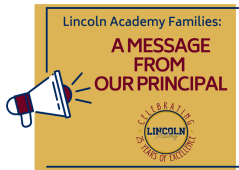

Friday, September 20

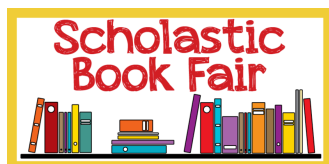

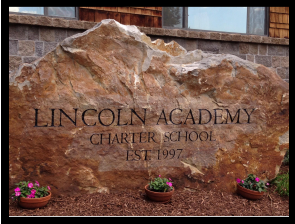
