Student Benefits Application

Although breakfast and lunch are now free for all, all families are strongly encouraged to complete a <u>Student Benefits Application</u> through Jeffco. This application, formerly known as 'free and reduced' or 'meal application' plays a critical role in determining many benefits for your student. If approved, the Student Benefit Application may allow waived school-related fees and field trip costs. By completing the application, you may also help Lincoln Academy secure additional state and federal funding, which can be used for supplemental literacy and math resources, hiring additional staff based on the school's needs, and professional development and training for staff.

Families must submit a new Student Benefits Application every year. Please go to SchoolCafe.com to sign in to your account or create a new account. Once logged in, select "Apply for Benefits" and it will take you from there! Please have this completed by the end of September. Logging Volunteer Hours

Please note it is <u>not</u> 1 hr PER ITEM. Almost all other volunteer tasks can be logged based on the amount of time you spend at the school or at-home working on a volunteer project.

This participation is an investment in our students and staff and is an important part of our Lincoln culture.
