Gifted and Talented students at Lewis & Clark Elementary School dug into the world of science and the lives of those that study it out in the field and will now embody their chosen type of scientist at the “Scientists in the Field” Living Wax Museum on Thursday.

In preparation for the Living Wax Museum, the third, fourth, and fifth graders chose an area of science that interests them and used the “Scientists in the Field” book series to research their topics and the scientists who study them.

During the Gifted & Talented Living Wax Museum, each student will dress up and play the role of their chosen type of scientist in the field. The students have prepared display boards and a presentation about their topic. Types of scientists include hurricane scientist, polar bear scientist, NASA scientist, frog scientists, octopus scientist, volcano scientist, and manatee scientist.

Other students from the school as well as parents and guests will be able to visit the museum in the school library and receive a lesson on these scholars in 20-minute shifts from 12:50-1:10 p.m., 1:20-1:40 p.m., and 1:50-2:10 p.m.

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
