Arlington National Cemetery: Changing of the Guard, Wreath Laying at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier (pending availability), JFK Gravesite and Memorial, Robert E Lee Mansion, Iwo Jima Memorial, National Archives, Museum of African-American History and Culture, Lincoln Memorial, WWII, Vietnam, and Korean War Memorials with an evening river boat dinner Cruise on the Potomac!

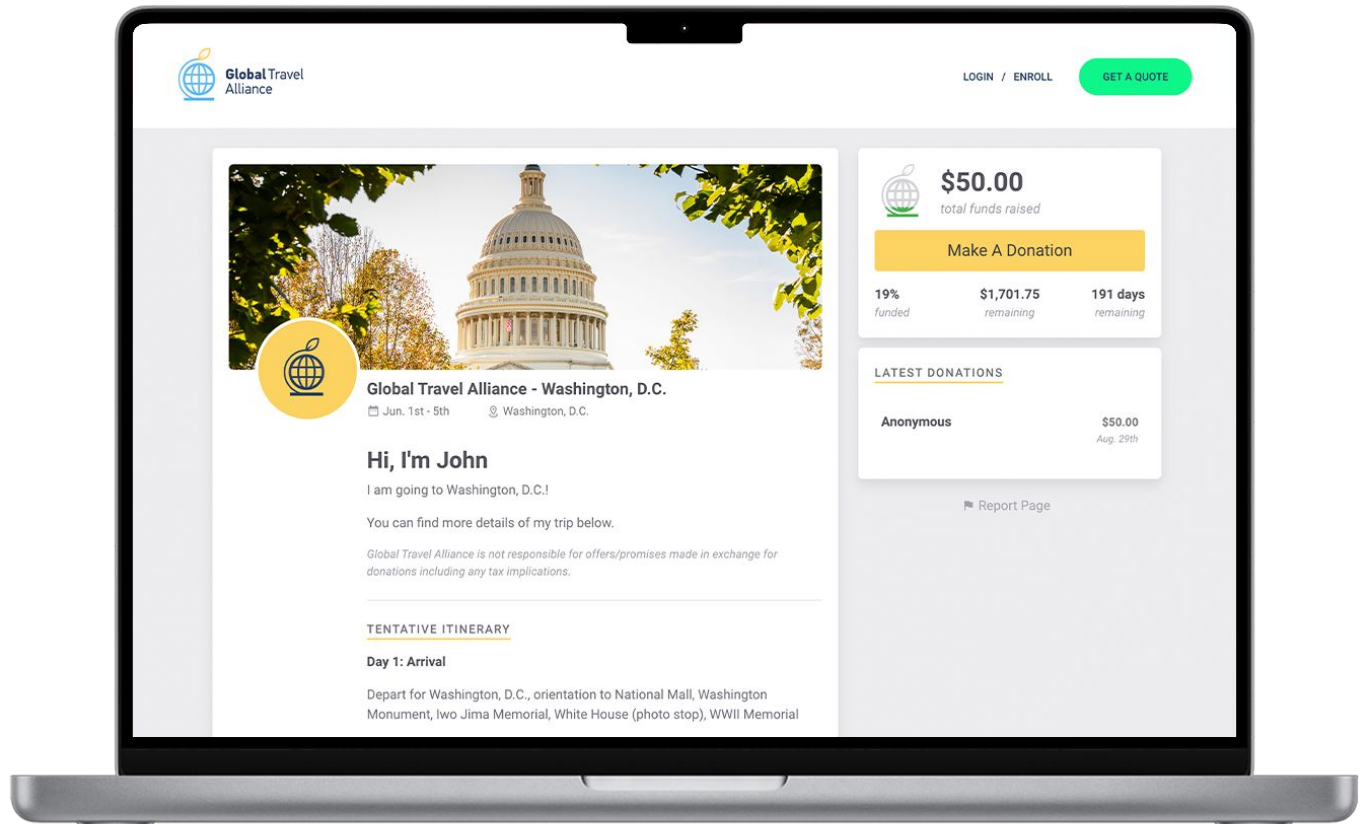
