Course Description:

Students in Stretch 8th grade advance their skills as leaders, critical and creative thinkers, independent explorers, and globally aware citizens. The goal is to provide experiences to gain a broader view of the world, take creative risks, and strengthen positive self-concepts. This course is individualized and student driven and is designed to meet the specific needs of the gifted learner. Placement into the gifted program is completed through a testing and application process.

The student will make connections between local issues and world trends.
