Building Safety Concerns

- Central Elementary
 - Sidewalk curb at bus pickup is deteriorating. Repair to be scheduled after the Greenock sidewalk is repaired.
 - Metal handrailing in front of building is beginning to rust and in need of replacement/repair
 - Chicken coop vandalization. No chickens were injured but increased surveillance will be installed with equipment removed from the high school due to renovations
- High School
 - Report that door nearest the greenhouse is being propped open and unattended during band practice. Reported to building secretary.
 - Concession stand fire begs the implementation of more stringent policy enforcement for facility usage. Group responsible for the fire has purchased replacement equipment.
 - Room 134 missing window screens. Supplies have been ordered and are waiting on installation.
 - Stairwell 6 exit's wooden ramp is deteriorating. Discussion surrounding the type of replacement. Construction will dictate if the repair is to be wooden or metal and concrete.
 - Room 201 Chem lab outlet
 - Gaming room wing near Mrs. Novak's room is in need of ventilation upgrades due to to construction vibration
