How Many Schools Should I Apply To?

- Reach/Target/Safety Schools
- Consider Application Fees
- Time to Work on the Applications

Most students will take the SAT or ACT two to three times.

- You should evaluate your scores and consider a college's application profile when you are considering **Test Optional**. If you do consider this route ensure the other components of your application are strong.
- Speak with Mrs. Williams if you believe you may qualify for a test fee waiver. If you qualify you may also be able to receive application fee waivers as well.

Application Deadlines

Early Action—Non Binding

Most deadlines are early November with admissions response by March 1.

Early Decision—Binding

Most deadlines are early November with admissions response by March 1.

Regular Decision

Deadlines are usually in December/January/February or Rolling Admissions.

SC Colleges Early Action Deadlines

October 15 Clemson & USC (Non-Binding)

October 22 Clemson Honors College

November 15 USC Honors College

November 15 CCU Early Action (Non-Binding)

December 15 College of Charleston (Non-Binding)

Information Needed for Applications

Demographics

Basic information -- Social Security #, Driver's License # if applicable, in-state colleges may ask for items to prove residency, etc.

Extra-Curricular Activities

Clubs, Sports, Community Organizations or Affiliations, Summer or Part-time Job Information

Honors or Awards/Recognition Received

List of awards or recognition while in high school for both school and community recognition.

Test Scores

Don't wait to complete application trying for a higher score.

The Common App essay prompts for the 2025–2026 application cycle will remain the same as last year. You can start early using the current prompts. The only change is to the 'Additional Information' section, now called 'Challenges and Circumstances,' with a reduced word limit of 300 words.

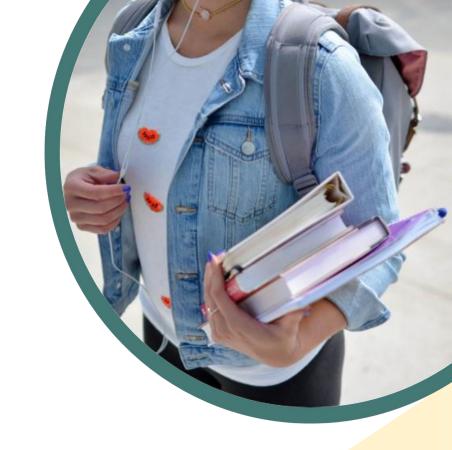

Community Recommenders

- Make them aware of the deadlines and instructions on where or how they should submit their recommendation.
- Give them as much notice ahead of a deadline as possible, but NO LESS THAN 10 BUSINESS DAYS.

It is YOUR responsibility to follow up with a recommender regarding deadlines and send a thank you note or email.
