B01	Destruction of School Property	Defacing or destroying school property including minor damage, which can be repaired or replaced at no cost to the District.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education, removal from non-curricular activities/programs).</li> <li>3. One day suspension w/restitution</li> </ol>
B02	Possession/ Inappropriate Use of Electronic Devices	A student shall NOT USE a cellular telephone or personal electronic communication devices (ECD) on school property during the school day.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices as outlined in the District Electronic Device Policy.</li> </ol>
B03	Forgery	Falsifying any information, which may include hall passes, permits, written communication from parents or school personnel, school records, and/or grades.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 3 day out-of-school suspension</li> </ol>
B04	Gambling	Participating in any games of chance or skill for the purpose of profit, of any kind, in or around school property.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 3 day out-of-school suspension</li> </ol>
B05	Gross Insubordination	Persistent refusal or abusive response to a directive made by an adult employee.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 3 day out-of-school suspension</li> </ol>

B06	Theft, Possession/ Transfer of Stolen Property	Taking something without permission from the school or another person that has a monetary value less than \$100.00.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 3-5 day out-of-school suspension</li> </ol>
B07	Use of Profanity	Swearing or use of inappropriate and profane language	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices as outlined in the attendance policy section of the Student Code of Conduct, beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education placement, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 1 day out-of-school suspension</li> </ol>
B09	Smoking	Possessing/smoking a cigarette, vaping, or using tobacco products on school property.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 3-5 day out-of-school suspension</li> </ol>
B10	Fighting	A confrontation between two or more persons that leads to physical contact.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education placement, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 1-3 day suspension</li> </ol>
B11	False Fire Alarm	Intentionally activating a fire alarm system in any school building on school property when no fire exists. A student will not destroy, damage, or otherwise tamper with a fire alarm in the school building.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education placement, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 1-3 day suspension</li> </ol>

B12	Breach of Security/ Trespassing	Entering building without permission/bypassing metal detector. Failing to identify oneself Being on school property without permission	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3. Maximum 3-5 day out-of-school suspension</li> </ol>
B18	Sexual Harassment	Inappropriate verbal, non-verbal, or written conduct of a sexual nature (unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, etc.) made by a student to another student or to an adult. (refer to pg. 23-25 in SCOC).	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consider 7 factors</li> <li>2. Use progressive disciplinary practices as outlined in the attendance policy section of the Student Code of Conduct, beginning with a student warning and parent contact (i.e. positive redirection, alternative education placement, removal from non-curricular activities/programs)</li> <li>3.
