SUBJECT: COMMUNITY EDUCATION

The Sweet Home School District shall provide opportunities through a year round Community Education program to make school facilities and programs available to District residents of all ages.

Programs shall provide educational, vocational, avocational, recreational and special interest opportunities in accordance with the needs and interests of residents.

Staffing

- a) Community Education shall be administered by a Director assisted by a Community Advisory Committee which shall deal with matters in accordance with this policy and rules.
- b) The program shall be staffed by qualified personnel as determined and hired by the Director.

Funding

Programs shall be self-supporting. Funding shall come from tuition, state aid, special grants, leasing of facility charges and other appropriate Community Education fund raising activities.

Facility Use

Regular daytime and after school programs for students in kindergarten through grade 12 shall continue to have first priority in the use of all school facilities.

Participants

- a) Participation in Community Education shall be open to all Sweet Home residents, regardless of age. Where space is available, non-residents may also participate.
- b) Activities which are otherwise self-supporting shall accept District residents, ages 60 or over, free of charge.
- c) Activities exclusively designed for those age 60 and over may have a nominal fee.
