

### Writing Workshop

Saturday June 14–July 12 (5 workshops: June 14, 21, 28/July 5 & 12th) 10:00am –12:00pm

#### **WHAT**

This workshop will include lectures on the book publishing industry, but the main focus will be on the participants' book proposals and their revision. Each revised proposal will be at least 20 pages. You will learn about the importance of argument, reporting, and sourcing your narrative nonfiction as well as imbuing it with urgency and tension.

### **WHAT**

Throughout the workshop, participants learn essential storytelling techniques, explore alternative narrative perspectives, and ultimately share their completed one-page comics, celebrating their new skills in visual storytelling and leaving with a finished creative product.
