Senior Graduation Contract Santa Fe Indian School

This contract must be agreed to by both parents and graduating seniors. Agreements will be kept on file on NASIS and Registration Summary.

As a member of the Santa Fe Indian School Class of 2026, I will participate in the 2026 graduation ceremony beginning at 10:00 am on Friday, May 29, 2026 (unless other date specified) at the Pueblo Pavilion Wellness Center.

I understand that participation in the ceremony is a privilege, not a right, and participation is not required to receive my diploma, if it has been earned. In order to participate in the graduation ceremony, I agree to the following:

- 1) I will pay the fee by April 15, 2026 for a cap and gown, to be worn during the graduation ceremony.
- 2) I will pay my senior fee by April 15, 2026. This fee is to defray the cost of the senior banquet, the purchases of the class gift to the school, and the gift to the keynote speaker.
- 3) I will participate in the mandatory graduation practice on a date that is to be announced (unless other date specified) at the Pueblo Pavilion Wellness Center. I understand, missing practice excludes me from participating in the official graduation ceremony. It is imperative to make arrangements as soon as possible with parents, employers, or others to avoid missing practice.
- 4) I understand that participation in senior activities is a privilege. I understand if I am not on track to graduate in May 2026, I will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony and senior banquet.
- 5) I understand that violations of school rules that result in placing a senior on activity restriction may result in the revocation of all senior privileges, including participation in the graduation ceremony, senior prom, senior class trip, and senior banquet.
- 6) I agree to follow all directions of the Santa Fe Indian School staff during the graduation practice and during the graduation ceremony. I understand it is a requirement to wear traditional attire for graduation ceremony. Any violation of school rules on the day of graduation will result in removal of the student from campus.
- 7) Banquet guests: As a graduate, I am entitled to bring no more than **two (2)** guests for the senior banquet-TBD (unless other date specified).
- 8) Diplomas and official transcripts will be issued to students who are financially cleared from the business office.
- 9) **Signatures** (this contract requires **BOTH** student and parent/guardian signatures) (On NASIS-OLR).
