

Dear Piney Ridge Elementary School Families,

We have just passed the halfway point of the school year. Quarter 2 report cards were sent home on January 3lst. This is a good time for students and parents to review progress from the first two quarters and set goals for the second half of the school year.

In January, our students worked hard while taking mid-year assessments for ELA and Math. Early this month, staff will compile and analyze the results of those assessments. This information will help us to fine-tune instruction and continue our work toward meeting the school's goals to increase achievement.

We would like to remind families that students are not permitted to bring candy or other food items to school for the purpose of sharing with others. Occasionally at a teacher's discretion, a class may have activities to recognize a holiday such as Valentine's Day. In these instances, teachers may permit students to bring cards or non-edible items to share. There are many students in the school who have food allergies, food sensitivities, or medical conditions which prohibit them from eating certain foods or treats.

Lastly, we encourage families to monitor information from CCPS regarding implementation of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future. Information is updated regularly on the CCPS website. The Superintendent will host two community Town Hall meetings to discuss the topic this Spring. The first Town Hall will be at nearby Century High School on March 5th at 6:00 PM.

Kindergarten Registration March 24-28, 2025

Kindergarten is mandatory in the State of Maryland. Your child must be 5 years of age by September 1, 2025. If your child is in Pre-K at PRE this year, documentation will roll over. No further action necessary at this time.

Parents are required to provide:

- Photo ID of parent
- Proof of birth—birth certificate, hospital certificate, baptismal certificate, birth registration, or passport/visa
- Verification of residence such as a current utility bill (ex:gas, electric, water, cable all of which must include the service address) a current lease agreement or settlement document.
- Current Immunization Record- Immunizations are also required at the time registration. Please contact your
 pediatrician for a copy or print from your healthcare portal. State vaccination records can also be retrieved from
 https://md.myir.com/ and create an account. You will also receive a health inventory, dental and lead form during
 registration.
