School-aged children between the ages of 7-17 in households receiving certain public assistance or approved for free/reducedprice school meals may be eligible for Sun Bucks.

# Get Help Buying Groceries This Summer with SUN Bucks!

SUN Bucks is Minnesota's summer grocery benefit program (formerly called Summer EBT). It provides \$120 per eligible schoolaged child to help families buy groceries when school is out

### Who Qualifies?

### Your child may be eligible if:

Your household already receives SNAP, MFIP, Medicaid, Tribal TANF, FDPIR, or Foster Care

Your child attends a school offering free/reduced-price meals AND your income qualifies

## Can I Opt Out?

If you opt out of SUN Bucks, you will not receive SUN Bucks benefits because MDE and DCYF will not be able to determine eligibility and know where to mail your SUN Bucks card(s).

### **How Does It Work?**

- You'll get \$120 per eligible child on a special EBT card
- Use it at grocery stores and farmers markets
- Buy healthy foods like fruits, vegetables, meat, dairy, and whole grains

### How Do I Get SUN Bucks?

Most families will be enrolled automatically. If you're not automatically enrolled but think you qualify, fill out the Educational Benefits form on our website:
