- **Secretary Report:**
 - March 10, 2025 meeting minutes were emailed to membership on 3/11/25. C. Gillespie motioned to approve N. Flowers seconded.
- **Treasurer Report:**
 - Updated reports emailed.
 - Reminder that all approvals are to be emailed to the athletic booster yahoo email (nkathleticboosters@yahoo.com) and that the board has two weeks to approve all requests.
- **Sponsorship Report:**
 - In discussions with Uli Sausage to talk about donating to concessions next year.
 - Sending out a letter to area businesses to inform who “On Time Sports” really are and that only 10% of money donated through them actually makes its way back to NKHS Athletics, as well as merchandise (t-shirts, calendars, etc). On Time sports is a legitimate company and the school does have a legitimate contract with them that was established before the Boosters were really trying on their own to get sponsorships from the community. So now we are competing with each other and On Time Sports presents themselves as being direct representatives from the school even though they are not and they do not inform the businesses that only 10% of actual dollars are given to the school. 90% is used as overhead and as merchandise which everyone agrees we could do without.
 - If anyone knows of any local businesses that are interested in donating directly to athletics at NKHS, let Karen Beers know.
- **Fundraiser Report:**

- Lil Norway / Dave Snyder Invitational Track Meet – April 19 – Boosters will run concessions with all proceeds going towards the Dave Snyder Scholarship Fund. QR codes will also be available for direct donations. Food Trucks will be on-site. Sign-up genius was emailed to membership.
- Jersey Mike Fundraiser in May – donating free sandwich cards with minimum \$5 donation to be redeemed May 19-23 and all donations will go directly back to boosters for a “fund an item” for the athletic medicine department. 750 cards available. Will pass out at Viking Fest and around town. Let Karen Beers know if you would like cards to pass out. This has the potential to be a huge fundraiser if we have lots of participation.
- Viking Crush Update
 - September 13, 2025 at Whitehorse, will come quickly after the beginning of school and also before any home football games so will need to get creative with selling raffle tickets.
 - Title sponsor secured
 - Casino donating food again
 - Mr. Rodgers will help secure athletes and coaches participation.
 - Thinking of new and creative ways to involve teams that would allow distribution of donations directly to teams based on participation.
 - Committees to be formed for silent auction, decorating, etc
- **Concessions Report:**
 - Will not restock candy unless we completely run out before the playoff season. What we have is what we have, trying to sell what is available.
 - In June we will need volunteers to help clean out the concession stands, moving things to storage for the summer.
- **Scholarship:**
 - Current application and rubric are posted on the Booster page of the school website.
 - Applications are due no later than May 1st at 2:30pm to the Athletic Office. Guidelines for turning in scholarship are clearly stated on the application form.
 - Don't forget that a recommendation letter from a NKHS Coach, Teacher, or Administrator is part of the application requirement.
 - Depending on how many applications are received will determine total amount of money to be awarded. Maximum 12 recipients will be chosen.
- **Spirit:**
 - Student Signing Event coming together. June 3 at 6:30pm. Names coming in from coaches. Boosters will provide light refreshments, MC, signage, table with black table cloths and then families can decorate individual tables.
- **Athletic Director Report:**
