Assumptions

Adjustments from January

- Anticipate lower revenues and increased health care costs
- Reduced COLA from 3.29% to 2.30%
- State continues to balance the multi-year budget using one-time funds for ongoing costs
- Tax deferrals for fire burn areas complicates projections
- Transitional Kindergarten remains at 10:1 for 2025-26
- Governor and Legislature still negotiating, so proposals are still proposals regarding:
 - Additional LREBG Funding
 - LCFF TK Ratio Add-On
 - Discretionary Block Grant
 - Teacher Preparation and Professional Development
 - Universal ELO-P Lowered to 55% Threshold



State Budget Factors for 2025-26

- Guaranteed COLA 2.30%
- Pension Cost Forecasts CalSTRS rate hold steady and CalPERS rate slightly down
- No reserve cap; therefore, Board commitments are not required


Approved 2024-25 Adopted Budget June 2024 2025-26 Governor's January budget proposal
