

5 Grade Organization

7 The District maintains instructional levels for grades kindergarten (K) through twelve (12). The
8 grouping and housing of instructional levels in school facilities will be according to plans
9 developed by the Superintendent or designee and approved by the Board.

11 Instructional programs shall be coordinated between each grade and between levels of schools.

13 A student will be assigned to an instructional group or to a classroom which will best serve the
14 needs of that individual while still considering the rights and needs of other students. Factors to
15 be considered in classroom assignments are: student age, class size, peer relations,
16 student/teacher relations, instructional style of individual teachers, and any other variables that
17 will affect the performance of the student.

19 Criteria for grouping will be based on the learning goals and objectives addressed and the
20 student's ability to achieve those purposes.
