Dear Hanford Seniors and Families!!!

This is a VERY exciting few weeks ahead, as our incredible Class of 2025 finishes up their high school education, moving on to bigger and better things...a lifetime full of possibilities!

We have some very important announcements about the graduation ceremony itself. The first one requires a change from past practice due to construction underway at the Toyota Center site.

PARKING CHANGES DUE TO CONSTRUCTION

Construction on the Three Rivers Convention Center (adjacent to the Toyota Center) started earlier than anticipated, which has resulted in limiting access to 500 parking spaces and other areas around the facility. Generally, all parking on site has been used for our ceremonies, meaning we need to reduce the amount of vehicles parking at the Toyota Center.

In order to support parking for all who plan to attend, the following requirements are in place:

1. **All graduating seniors must ride with families to the Toyota Center.** If students want quick access to vehicles, you may want to park nearby at one of the large shopping centers and ride with families from there. Please note that additional parking for families, if needed, is available at Vista Field, which will require a short walk to the Center.
2. Following the ceremony, **we request all families to leave the Toyota Center parking lot no later than 6:30 pm.** Richland High School, who will be bussing their seniors to the Center, will need access to the limited parking available on site.

The map below shows the areas on site with restricted access, as well as the location of the additional parking on the NE corner of the site and at Vista Field. Also noted on the map are areas designated for ADA Parking for those in need.



We truly appreciate your cooperation so that we can ensure all of our families--and especially our grandparents and other relatives--are able to access parking reasonably close to the Center. Thank you!

CEREMONY DETAILS

Our 2025 Hanford High School Graduation Ceremony will be held on:

- **Friday, June 6th, 2025, at 4:30 PM at the Toyota Center**
 - Located at 7000 W. Grandridge Blvd., Kennewick, WA.
 - **Students must arrive by 3:50 PM & be lined up by 4:00 PM.**
- Each student who participates in the graduation ceremony will wear the proper cap & gown as designated by the school administration & the class advisor & officers.
- Students will dress & participate in the graduation ceremony in the manner designated by the school administration and/or class advisor.
 - NO JEANS & NO FLIP FLOPS
- **Tickets are not required for admission to graduation.**

Please note: Toyota Center Security will clear all seats between Hanford High School and Richland High School ceremonies.

Approved Bags

Clear Bag **Clear Branded Bag** **One gallon clear resealable plastic storage bag**

Bags must be clear plastic, vinyl or PVC, and have a maximum of one logo or printed message 2 inches high by 2 inches wide.

OR

Small Bags The only non-clear bags permitted are small bags used for medical or infant no larger than the size of a hand.

All non-clear and/or larger than those shown above.
