We are incredibly grateful for your overwhelming support of the November 2022 bond levy. Your commitment to our schools has made it possible to bring transformative upgrades to all five of our buildings—ensuring safe, modern, and functional learning environments for our students and staff.

I'm happy to share that renovations led by Infinity Construction are nearly complete across all five schools. Thanks to your support, we've accomplished an impressive list of upgrades this school year, including:

- Renovation of all restrooms, with the addition of single-use options
- Upgraded kitchens and cafeterias at the High School and Middle School
- Renovated locker rooms at both the High School and Middle School
- Updates to the High School's main entrance, lobby, auditorium, main office, and guidance office

We also extend our thanks to Vasco Sports for overseeing the renovation of the Copley-Fairlawn Middle School Track and Field Complex. The new turf, track surface, seating, and lighting have made a tremendous impact.

And of course, we can't forget the Copley High School Stadium, which officially opened on August 20, 2024. Thank you to our community and to Summit Construction for bringing this incredible facility to life—a space we can all be proud of.

Looking ahead, parking lot repairs at all five buildings will begin this summer, with full completion expected by next summer. These improvements will include expanded parking and enhanced safety and accessibility. You'll also notice ongoing maintenance such as painting, lighting upgrades, and new signage throughout our facilities.
