

Military Liaisons

Military Liaisons support military students and families with integration into school, coordinate military-connected professional development opportunities for staff, and provide military families guidance and information to district, community, and military resources.

Specific role responsibilities:

- 1. Create and maintain an easily accessible web page that includes information for military-connected students and their families. (Purple Star Application Required)
- 2. Promote District designated military connected events:
 - a. Purple Up (Purple Ribbon) Week
 - b. Military Art Contest
 - c. April (Month of the Military Child)
 - d. November (Military Family Month)
 - e. Veteran's Day and Memorial Day
- 3. Take photographs and video of military connected events; document event details and promote on social media
- 4. Maintain, promote, and house the Purple Military Resource Tote
- 5. Host/offer military connected Professional Development for staff; maintain accurate sign-in sheets and campus military support records on file (*Purple Star Application Required*)
- 6. Conduct military connected family meetings at least 1 per semester
- 7. Attend district military support training and informational meetings held by the District Military Liaison/Military Support team
- 8. Serve as the point of contact on the campus for military connected questions (*Purple Star Application Required*)
- 9. Create a summary that highlights a military connected family for "Military Family of the Month"
- 10. If on a Purple Star campus, maintain the designation if re-application is necessary; if not on a Purple Star campus, complete the application process if the campus wishes to apply.
- 11. Must have a campus transition program that includes: (Purple Star Application Required)
 - Introductions to school environment and processes ("welcome" for student)
 - Student leaders or ambassadors should be supported or sponsored by a campus-based staff member. *Ideally student leader/ambassador is also a military connected student (peer)
 - Participate in organizing and hosting newcomer social events, facilitating guided tours of the campus, and accompanying new students to lunch during the first week of school.
- 14.Offer at least one of the following initiatives: (Purple Star Application Required)
 - A resolution showing support for military-connected students and families;
 - Participation in Month of the Military Child or Military Family Month; or
 - Partnership with a school liaison officer to encourage and provide opportunities for active-duty military members.
