Summer Boot Camp:

As a means of orientation, our team will have a summer boot camp to get students on board and ready for the school year on **Tuesday, July 29, 2025**. The camp will be held from **9:00 AM - 11:00 AM** with a parent meeting at 11:00 AM in the cafeteria, which will last about thirty minutes. This orientation will be held at LCMS-West. During this time students will participate in team building activities, and take a tour of the school. At the parent meeting we will discuss the schedule, behavior expectations, supplies needed, team routines, and procedures. While attendance is not mandatory, this will be our team's only time for students and parents to spend with their teachers and ask questions about the upcoming school year. From past experience, we have found that this is a great opportunity to get your student started off on the right foot for middle school. **If you and your student participate in boot camp, you will not need to attend the regularly scheduled open house once school begins.** Drop your student off in the front of the school by 9 AM.
