7 The Board believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital component in the growth
8 and education of the student and recognizes the responsibility to keep parents informed of
9 student welfare and progress in school.

11 The issuance of grades and progress reports on a regular basis serves as a basis for continuous
12 evaluation of the student's performance and for determining changes that should be made to
13 affect improvement. These reports will be designed to provide information that will be helpful to
14 the student, teacher, counselor and parent.

16 The Board directs the Superintendent or designee to establish a system of reporting student
17 progress and will require all staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching
18 responsibility. Staff members, parents and teachers are valued participants in this process.
