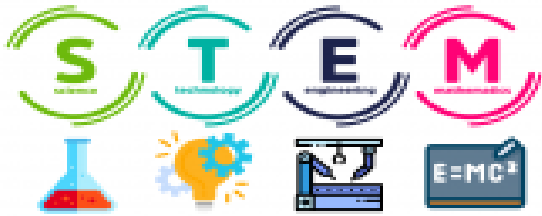

6th Grade Boot Camp

As a means of orientation, teams will have a summer boot camp to get students on board and ready for the school year on **Tuesday, July 29, 2025**. The camp will be held from **9:00 AM - 11:00 AM** with a parent meeting at **11:00 AM**, which will last about thirty minutes. This orientation will be held at LCMS West. We will be addressing the schedule, behavior expectations, supplies needed, team routines, and procedures. While attendance is not mandatory, this will be **a time for students and parents to meet with their teachers and ask questions about the upcoming school year**. From past experience, we have found that this is a great opportunity to get your student started off on the right foot for middle school.

Student Pick Up: Pick up your child after attending the parent meeting

Parent Meeting: 11:00 AM-until in the LCMS West Gym

For the **Parent Meeting**, parents can park in the bus parking lot behind the LCMSW gym for the meeting. Signs will be placed outside with directions.

Students can bring first day supplies and any locker decorations with them to bootcamp to lighten the load on the first day of middle school.
