Artificial Turf Fields

To maintain the safety, functionality, and beauty of our artificial turf fields, we ask all users to treat them with care and respect.

By following the rules outlined in this agreement, you are helping to preserve these facilities for future generations. If you witness any misuse or damage caused by another group, please report it immediately to the school district. Your cooperation ensures that our community continues to enjoy safe, well-maintained, and top-quality athletic spaces.

Rules for Renting School District Artificial Turf Fields

All outside groups renting and using the school district's artificial turf fields must adhere to the following rules and regulations to ensure the safety, cleanliness, and longevity of the facility:

General Use Rules

1. **Field Access:** Groups are required to have a Facility Use Permit to access our fields. Use of the turf field is only permitted during the scheduled rental time. Unauthorized use outside of approved hours is prohibited.
2. **Field Protection:** Only players, coaches, and approved personnel are allowed on the turf. Spectators must remain in designated seating or viewing areas.
3. **Footwear:** Metal cleats, sharp-edged footwear, or any shoes that could damage the turf are prohibited. Only molded cleats or turf shoes are allowed.
4. **Scoreboards, Lights and Public Address-**There is no expectation for groups to access our scoreboards, lights or sound system without the expressed written consent on the Facility Use Permit. These options will result in a higher rate of pay and possibly payment in advance.

Prohibited Items & Activities

4. **Food & Beverages:** No food, gum, sunflower seeds, or shelled nuts are allowed on the turf.
5. **Drinks:** Only clear, non-colored water is allowed on the field. Sports drinks, soda, coffee, or any other colored beverages are strictly prohibited.
6. **Tobacco & Alcohol:** Smoking, vaping, tobacco products, and alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the premises.

7. **Glass & Sharp Objects:** Glass bottles, cans, or sharp objects that could puncture or damage the turf are not permitted.
8. **Pets:** No animals are allowed on the field, with the exception of service animals.
9. **Equipment Use:**
 - Do not drag heavy equipment, chairs, or benches across the turf.
 - Portable soccer goals, lacrosse nets, and other equipment must have proper rubber feet or turf-safe bases.
 - No use of fences as backstops, rebounding surfaces, or ball toss hitting stations.
10. **Vehicles:** No bicycles, scooters, rollerblades, or motorized vehicles (except for authorized maintenance vehicles) are allowed on the turf.

Field Maintenance & Damage Reporting

11. **Trash & Cleanup:** All groups must clean up after use, including removing trash and placing it in designated receptacles.
12. **Damage Reporting:** Any damage to the field, equipment, or surrounding facilities must be reported immediately to the school district. The renting group may be held responsible for the cost of repairs.
13. **Weather Policy:** In the event of severe weather (lightning, heavy rain, or extreme temperatures), use of the field may be suspended. The school district reserves the right to cancel or reschedule use for safety reasons.

Compliance & Enforcement

14. **Supervision:** A responsible adult must be present at all times to oversee participants and ensure compliance with rules.
15. **Failure to Comply:** Violations of these rules may result in loss of rental privileges, fines, or additional charges for damage or cleaning.

By signing the rental agreement, the group acknowledges and agrees to follow all stated rules and assumes responsibility for compliance.
