Updates included:

- A review of the Moving On ceremonies at Curtis and all elementary schools.
- Two School Committee members have been assigned to a Calendar Review Subcommittee to work alongside Lincoln Public and Lincoln Sudbury Regional High Schools to do their best to align school calendars. The work comes from the Tri-District meeting on April 9th where the three districts heard public comments supporting adding additional religious holidays, reviewed attendance data, and discussed a joint committee to have a formal process to review options to maximize calendar alignment for the 26-27 school year.
- Placement is underway at each school for the next school year. Enrollment is continuously monitored and any potential changes in class sections will be announced shortly.
