



2020 Bond Sale Update

- May 14th Final bond sale
- Deposits \$65.2M in Capital Projects
 Fund
- True Interest: 3.88%





Purpose of Bond Issuance

This sale is the fourth and final sale of bonds authorized at the February 2020 election

- The District voters authorized \$275,200,000 of UTGO bonds in 2020
- Deposited \$65,000,000 into capital projects fund with 2024 bond sale
- Approved vote of 61.29%

The Bond Proceeds will be used to:

- Renovate, modernize and enhance learning environments at River Ridge High School and Komachin Middle School
- Replace roofs and upgrade heating and cooling systems at the Horizon, Seven Oaks and Meadows Elementary Schools
- Make District-wide safety and security improvements, asset preservation improvements and safety life cycle upgrades
- Remodel the Raj Manhas Activity Center for occupancy by the Ignite Family Academy, currently located at Bower Learning Center







Alternative, Specialized & Choice Program Facilities







Aspire Performing Arts Academy



- Enrollment: About 325 students
- Needs: Classroom and general school spaces, specifically specialized to accommodate performing arts programs.





Envision Career Academy

- Enrollment: About 125 students
- Needs: Classrooms and general school spaces suitable for a variety of high school Career Technical Programs.





VOICE (Vocational Opportunities for Independent Community Employment)

- 18-22 Transition Program
- Enrollment: About 20-30 students
- Needs: Spaces to teach independent living skills & vocational skills; access to city transit and ideally walkable access to businesses and services.







Ignite Family Academy

IGNITE

- Homeschool Parent Partnership Program
- Enrollment: About 100 students based upon current constraints.
- Needs: Classrooms, meeting spaces for parents, meetings, and events, space for office/administrative support.







Summit Virtual Academy

- Virtual school serving students in Kindergarten-12th grade
- **Enrollment: About 350 students**
- Needs: Office/administrative support space, room for meetings with families, access to spaces for gatherings and events.









Family Youth Resource Center

- Provides clothing, resources, supports to families in need
- Enrollment: N/A
- Needs:
 - Storage space for clothing, school supplies, food, etc
 - Space for staff, meeting with families
