

Objective:

To provide a safe, respectful environment for user groups while protecting the integrity of our fields and facilities.

For Coaches & League Representatives

- Check in with the Stadium Coordinator upon arrival
- Water only on the turf. No food on the field or track
- Only players, coaches, officials, and approved league reps are allowed on the field. No children or siblings.
- No portable heaters or stakes allowed on the field
- Supervise your team at all times
- Clean up all belongings and garbage before leaving
- Leave the area in the same condition you found it
- In an emergency, inform the Stadium Coordinator so EMS access can be arranged.

For Players

- Clean cleats before stepping on the field
- No cleats on the track (including warm-ups)
- Water only—no food or other drinks on the field or track
- Use provided garbage cans for all trash

For Guests

- Remain in the stands during practices, games, and scrimmages
- Be respectful to others, staff, and volunteers
- No portable heaters allowed in the stands
- Clean up trash and take all belongings before leaving
- Follow all school district rules

School District Rules

- Be respectful to staff and others on district property
- No tobacco, vaping, alcohol, or profane language
- No weapons allowed at any time
- Only ADA service dogs are permitted (per RCW 70.84.021 and RCW 49.60.040). Comfort or emotional support animals are not considered service animals under Washington State law because they are not specifically trained (RCW 49.60.040).
- No pets, skateboards, or bikes
- No staking on turf. No propane heaters.

Our Stadium Coordinators and custodians work hard to support all users. If safety is compromised or rules are violated, you may be asked to leave.
