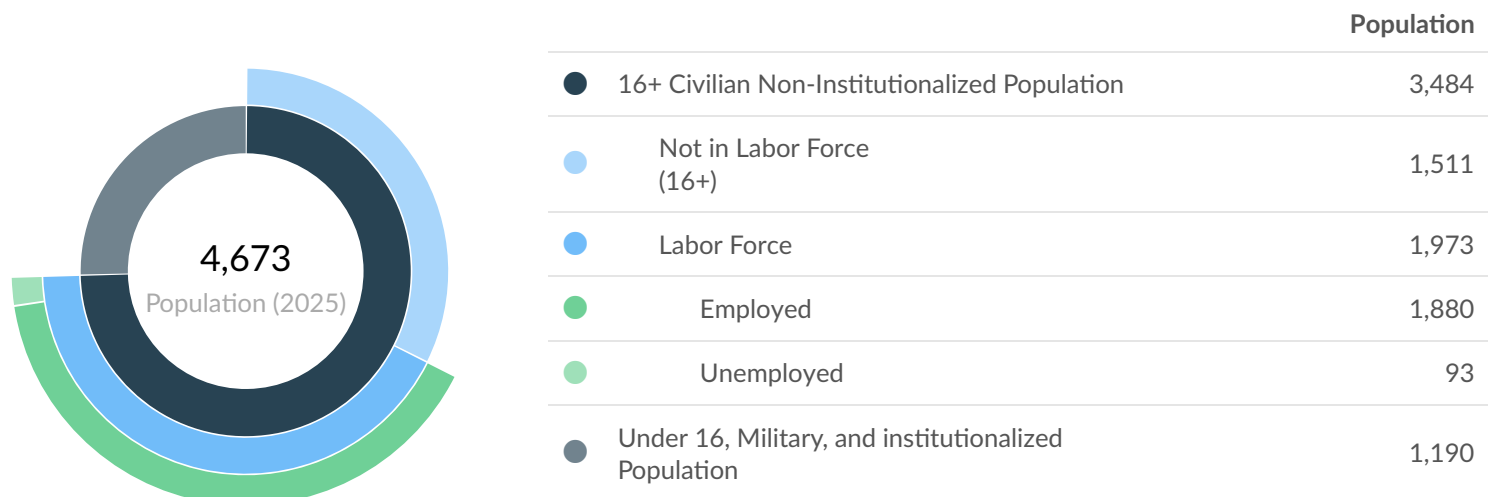
Median household income is **\$32.9K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 9.0%** since 2019, falling by 466. Population is expected to **decrease by 2.2%** between 2024 and 2029, losing 103.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **declined by 0.7%** in Jim Hogg County, TX from 1,992 to **1,979**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.1% by 4.8%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate increased from 54.0% to 56.6% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Jim Hogg County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **1.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (7.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Home Health Care Services, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Federal Government, Civilian.

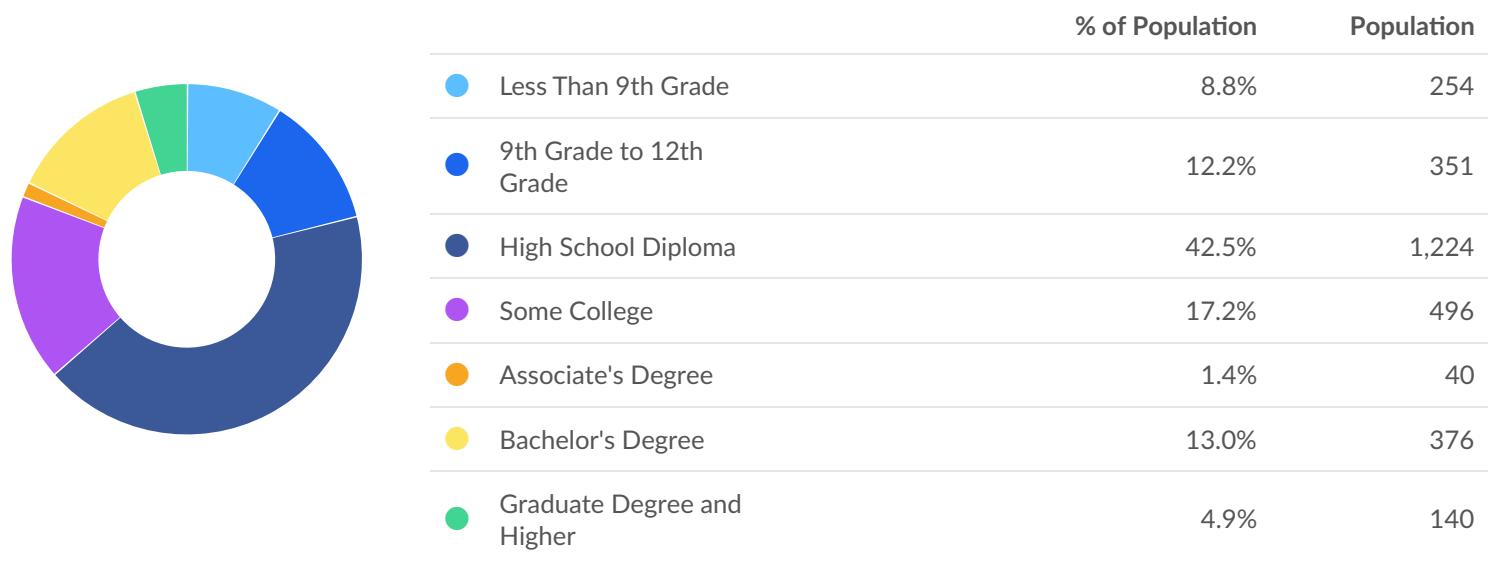

Mar 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



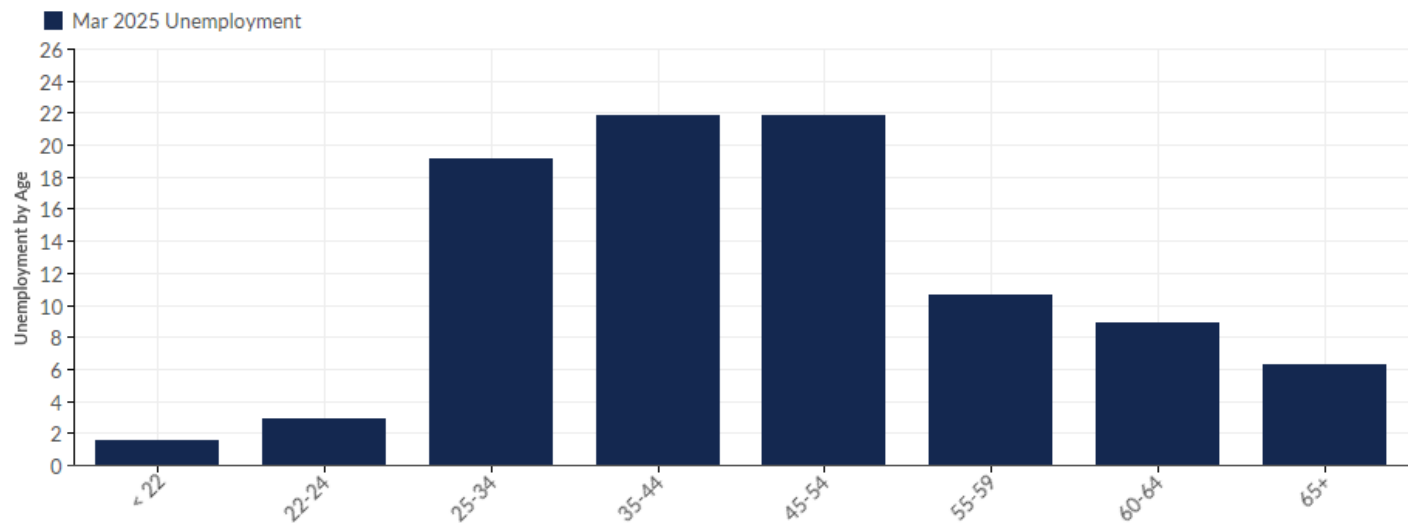
Educational Attainment

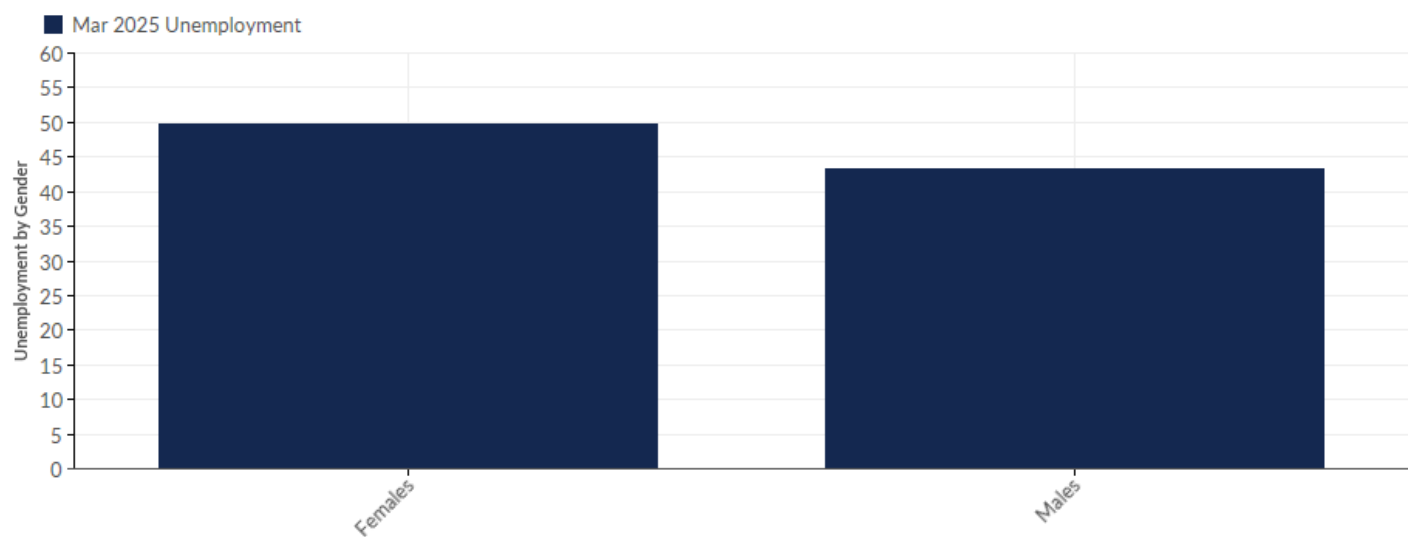

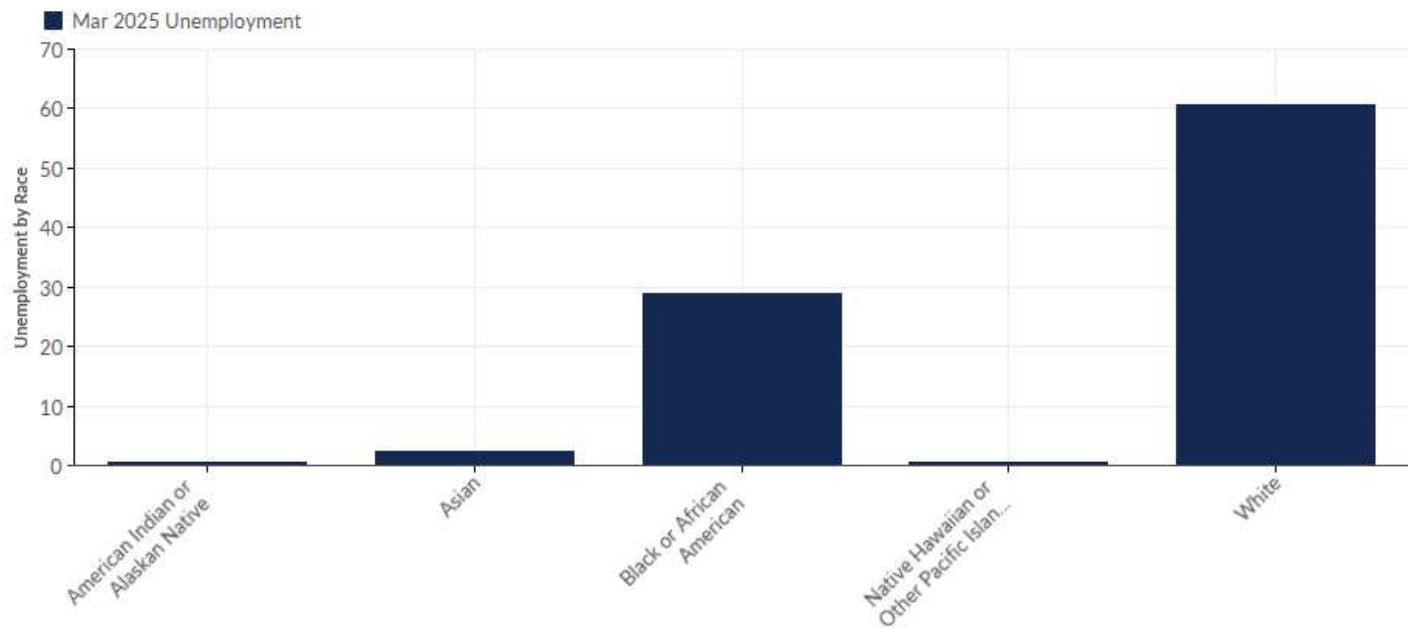

Unemployment by Gender



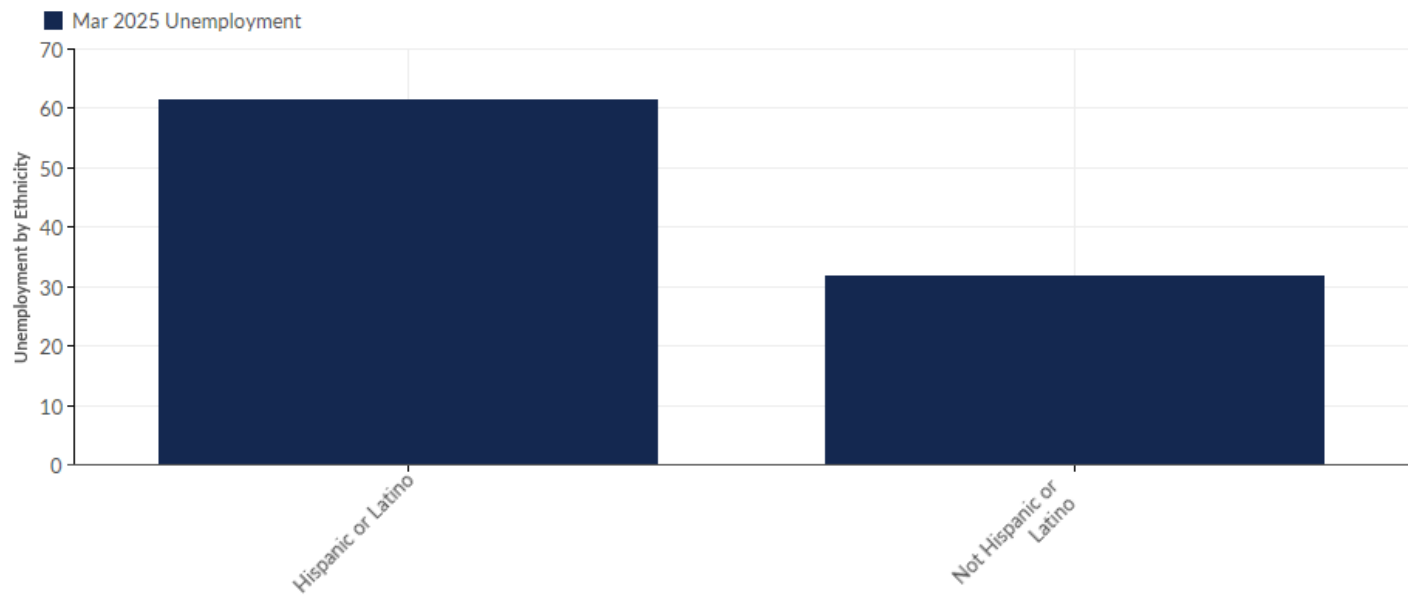

Unemployment by Ethnicity

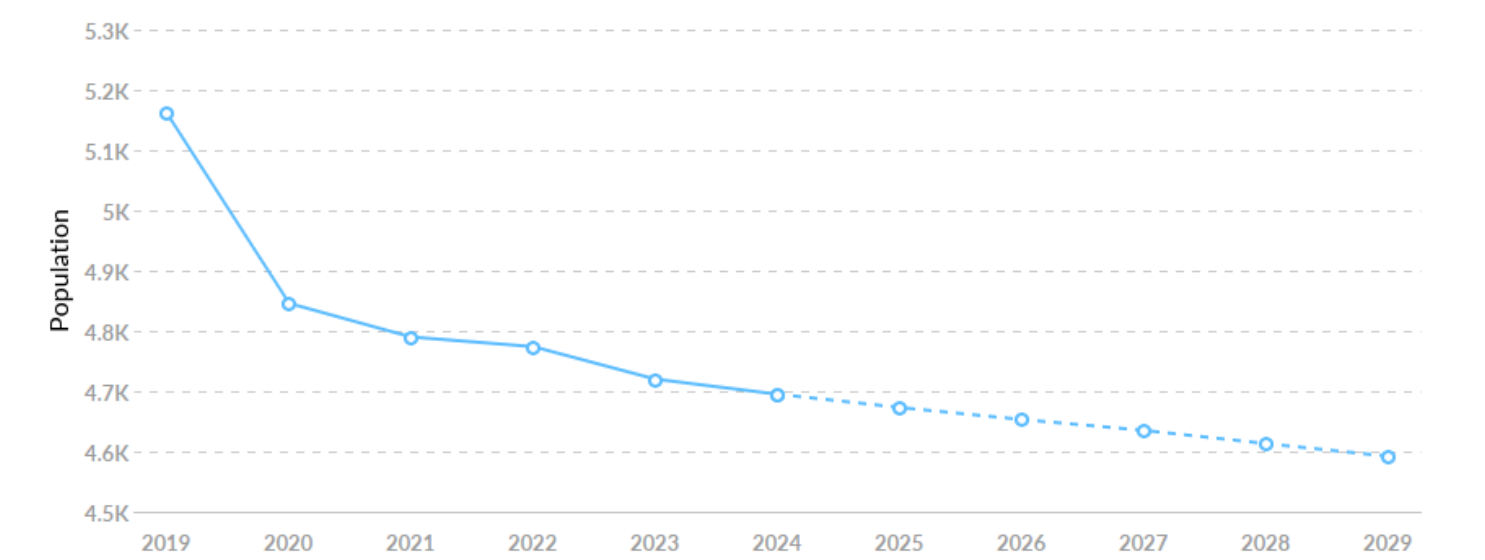

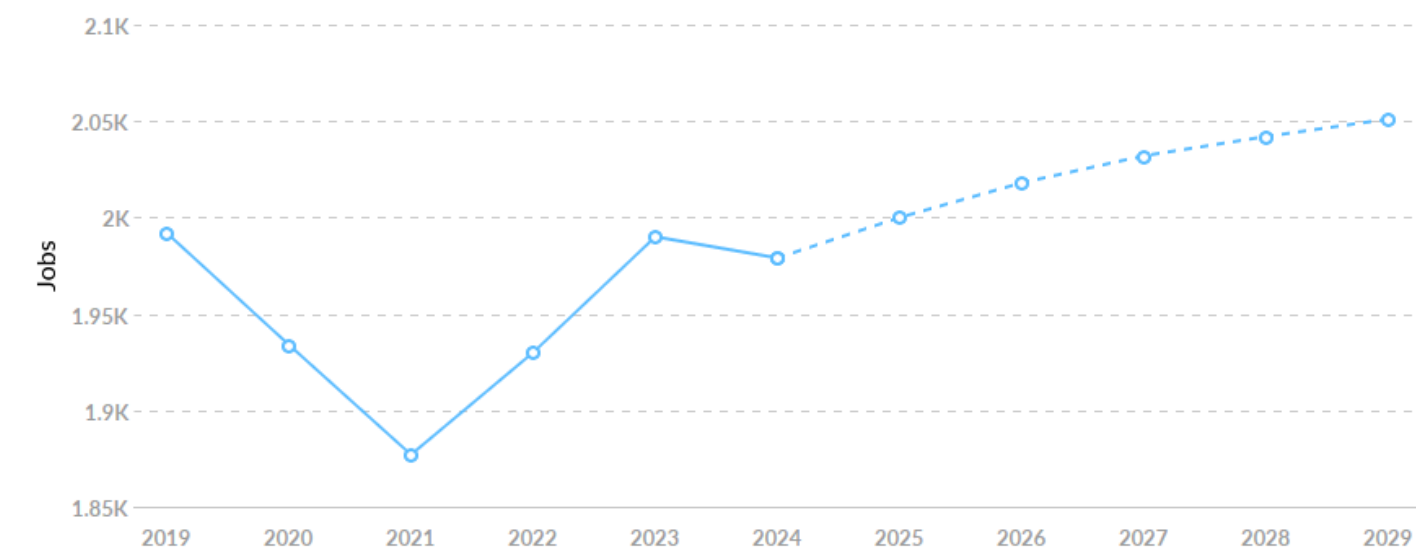

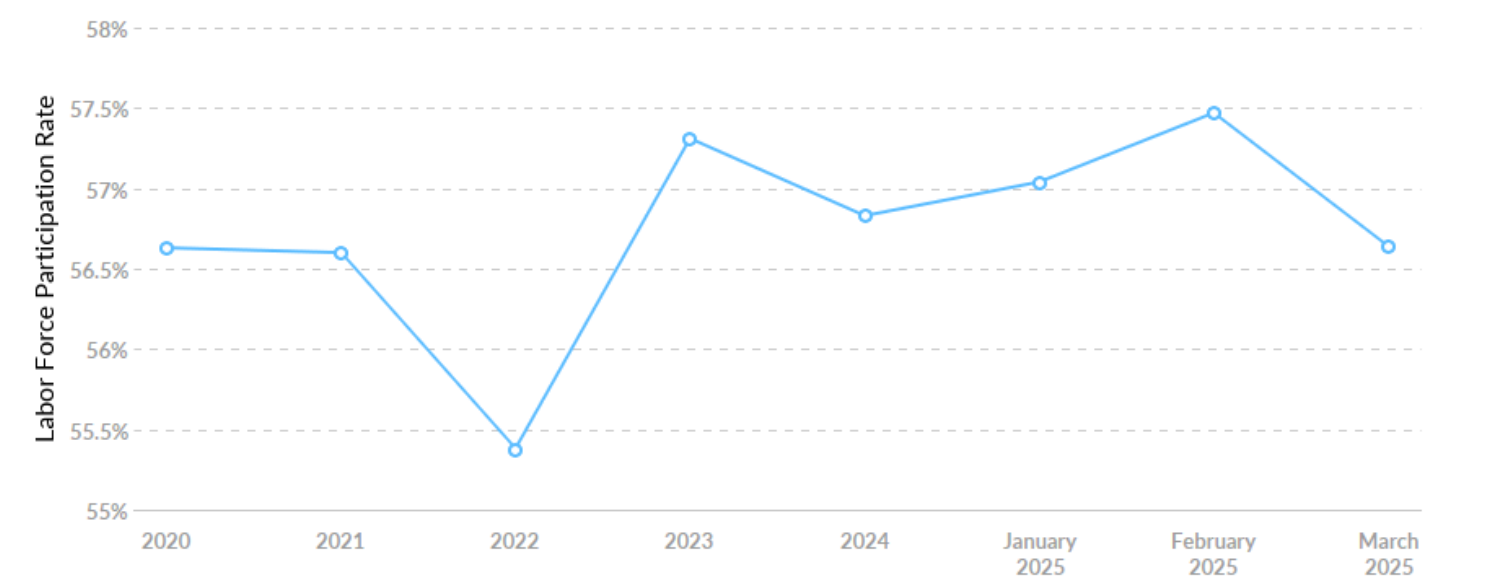
Job Trends

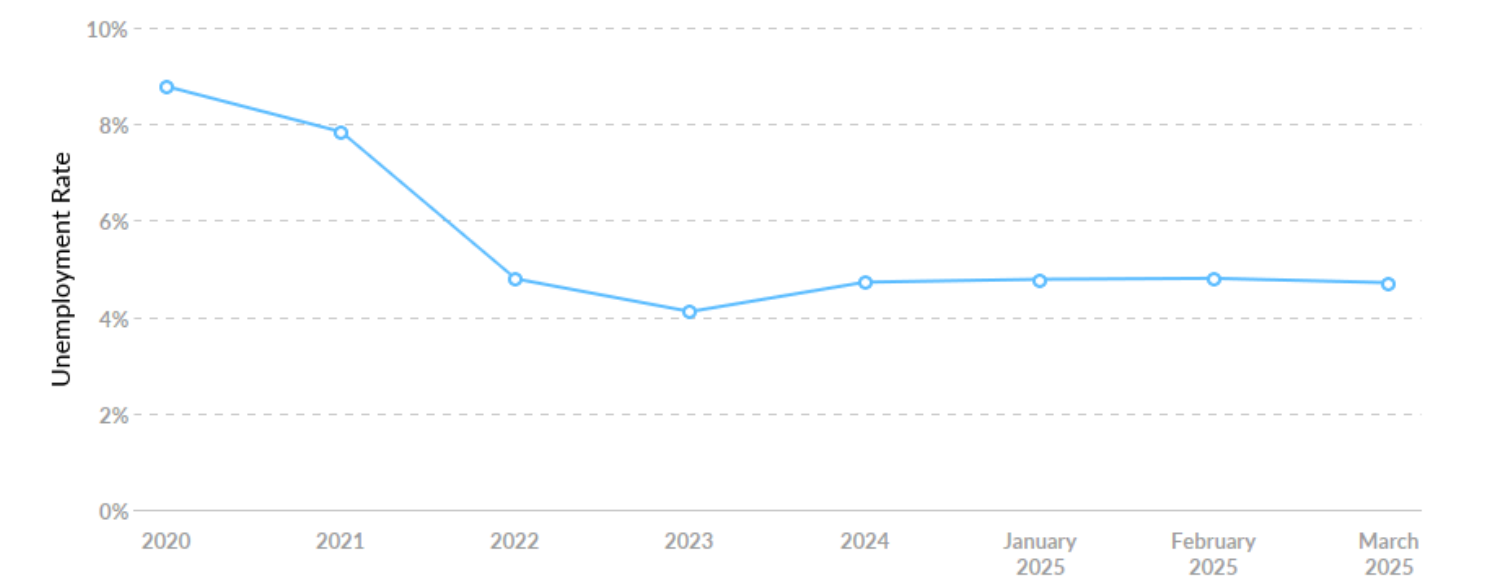

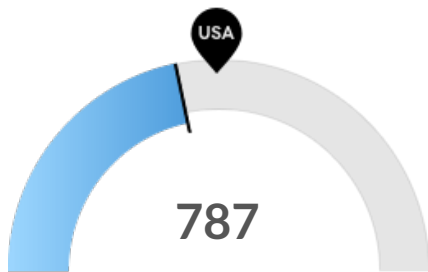
Unemployment Rate Trends

Jim Hogg County, TX had a March 2025 unemployment rate of 4.71%, **decreasing from 8.78%** 5 years before.



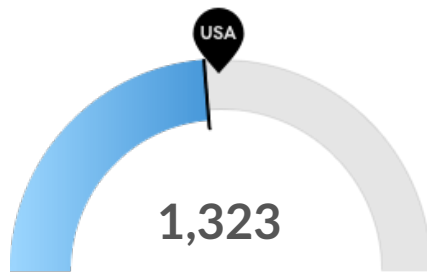

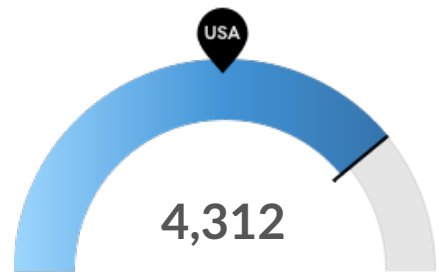
Millennials

Jim Hogg County, TX has 787 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 959.



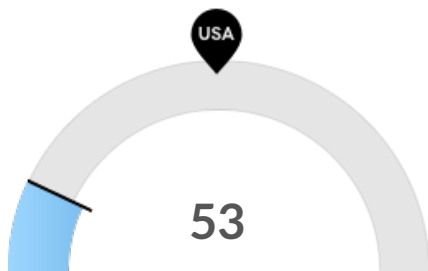
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Jim Hogg County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 1,425 people 55 or older, while there are 1,323 here.



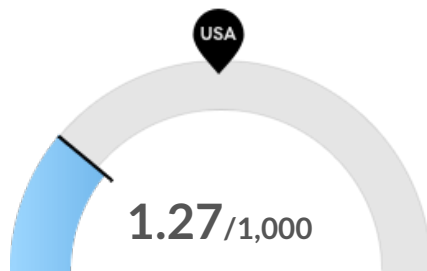
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Jim Hogg County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 1,966 racially diverse people, while there are 4,312 here.



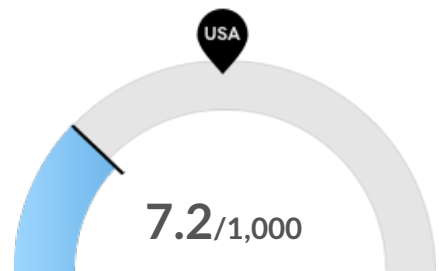
Veterans

Jim Hogg County, TX has 1.27 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

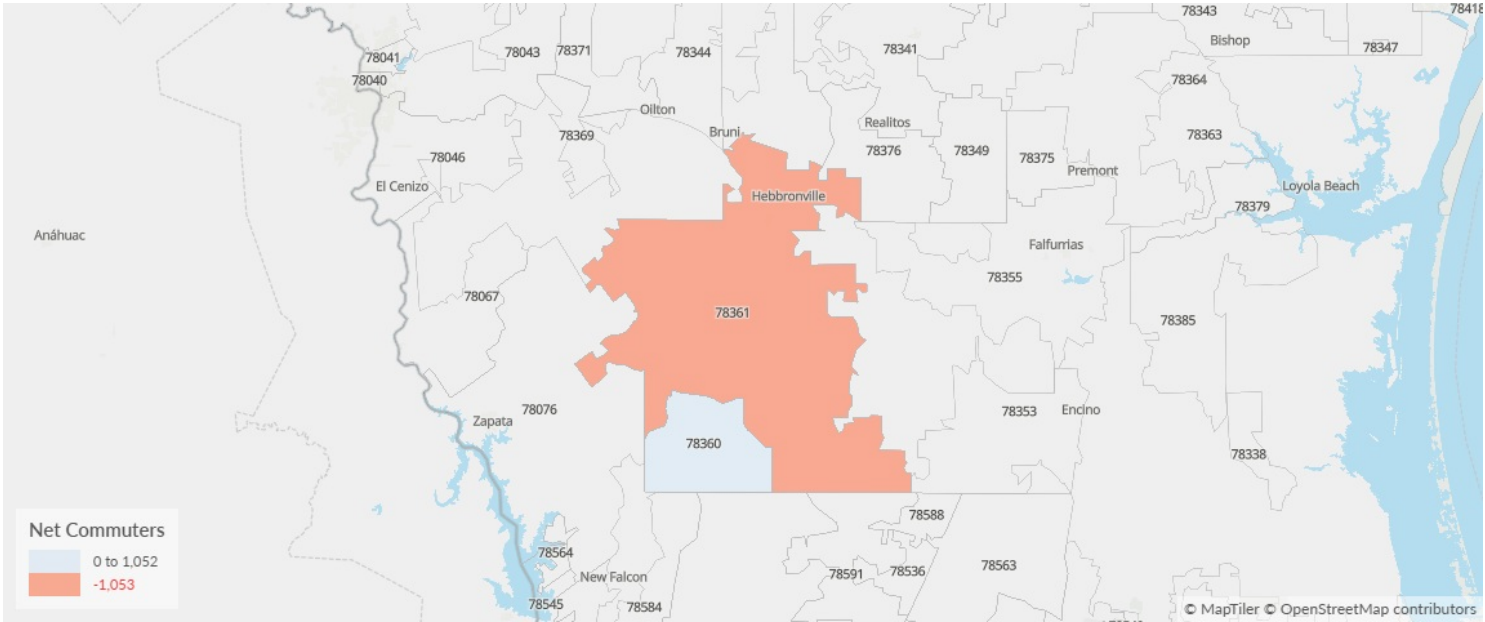


Property Crime

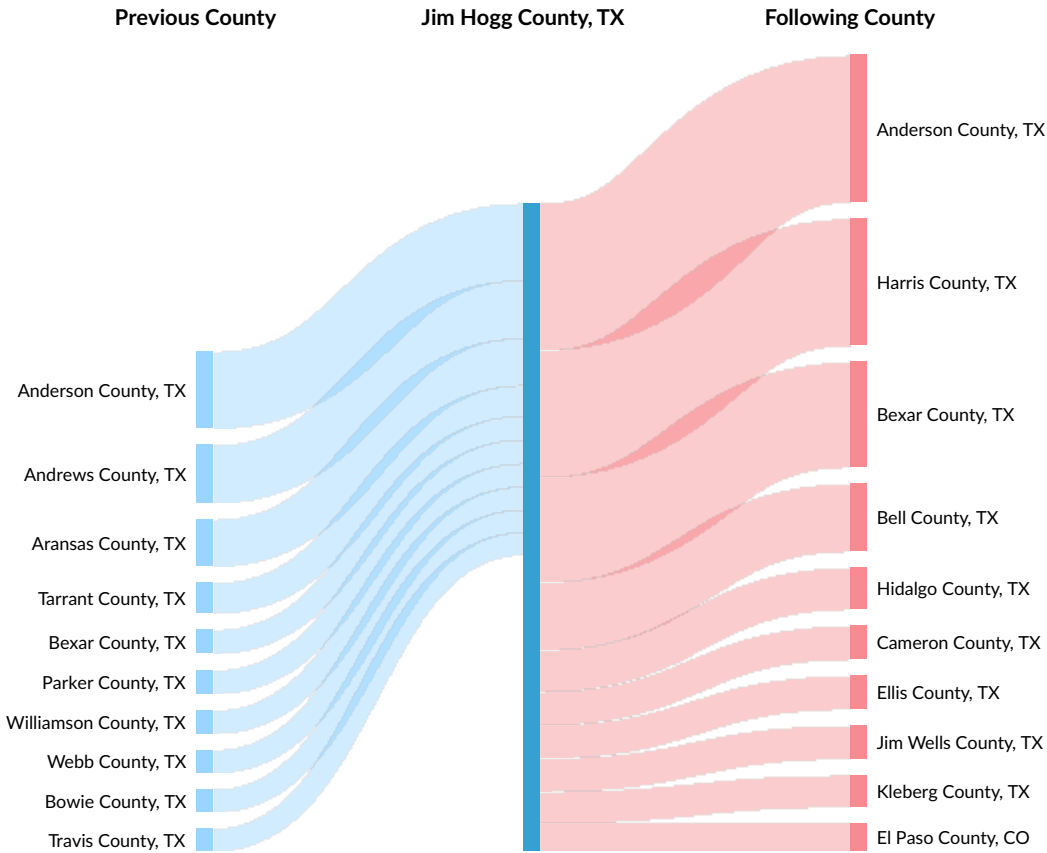

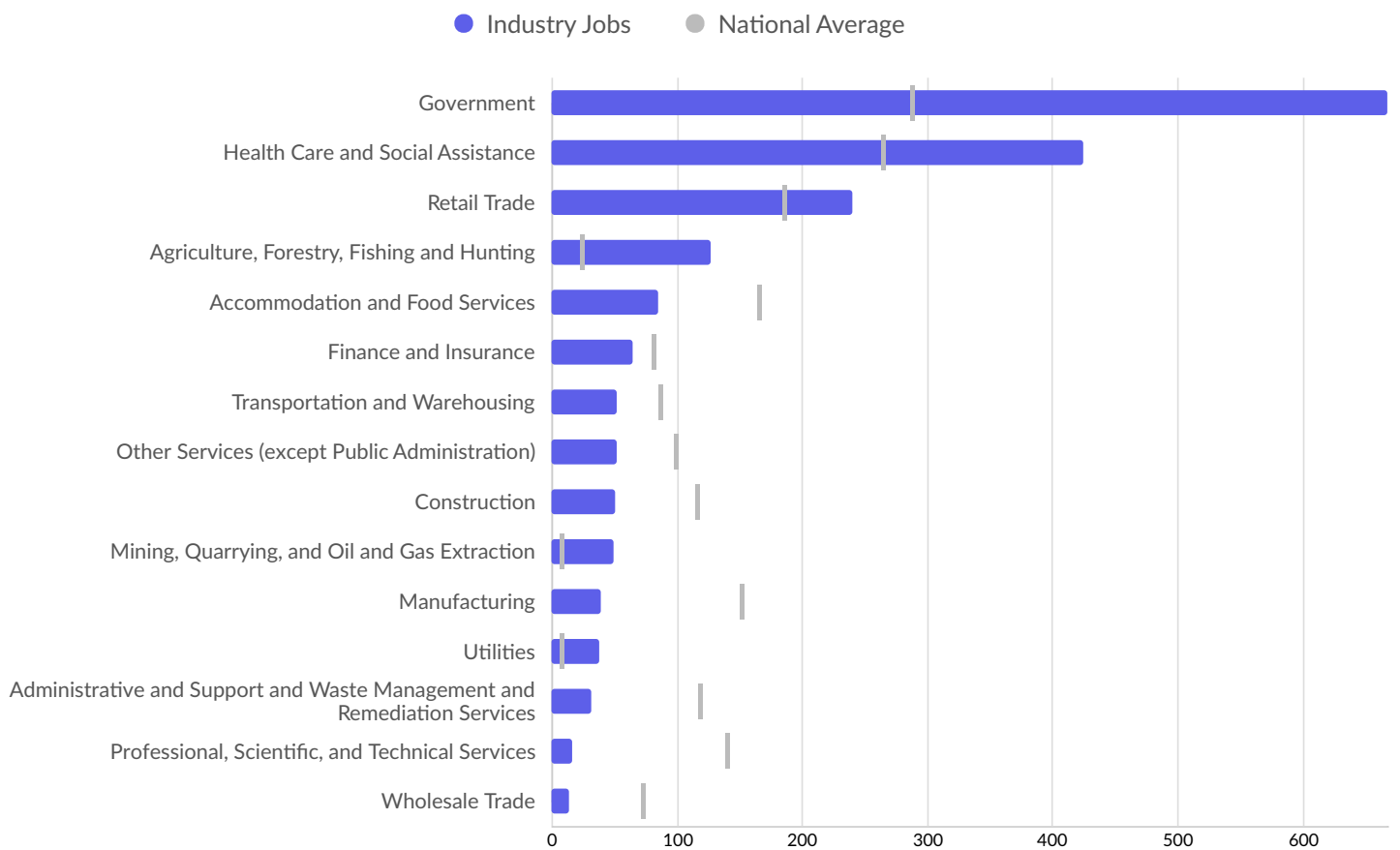

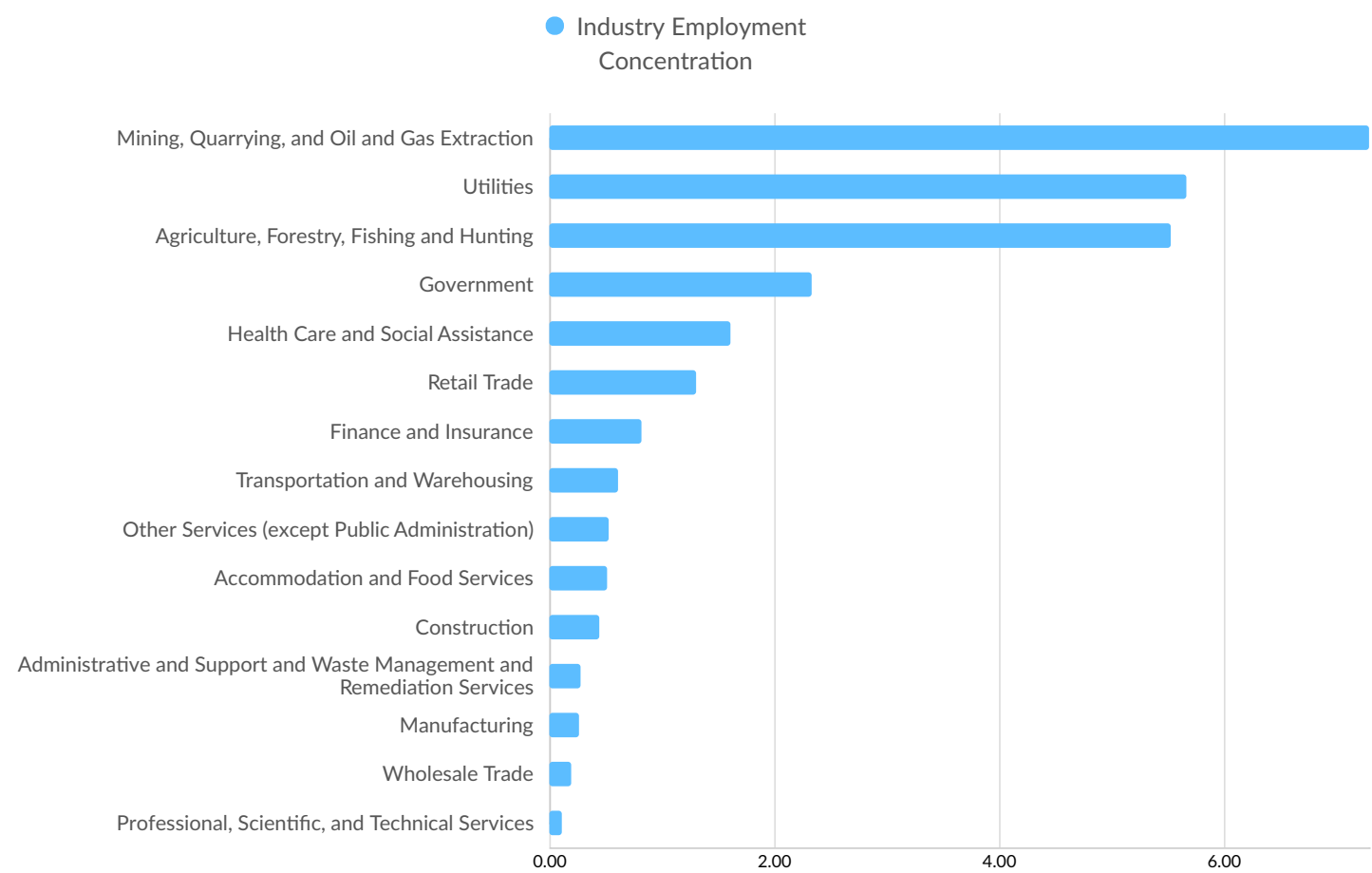

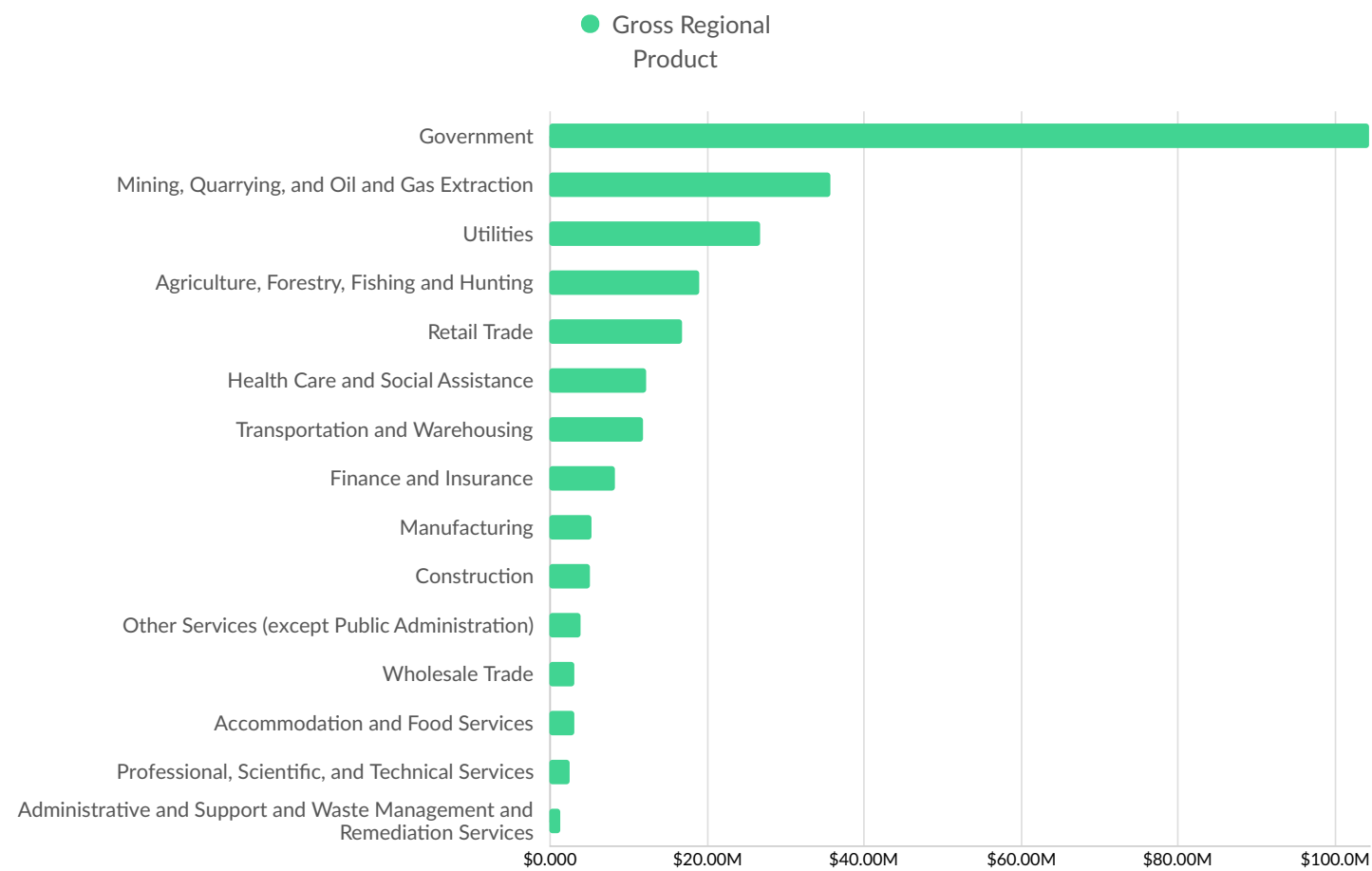
Top Growing Industries

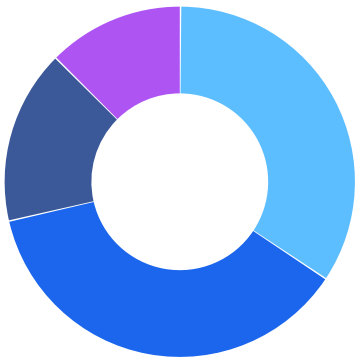

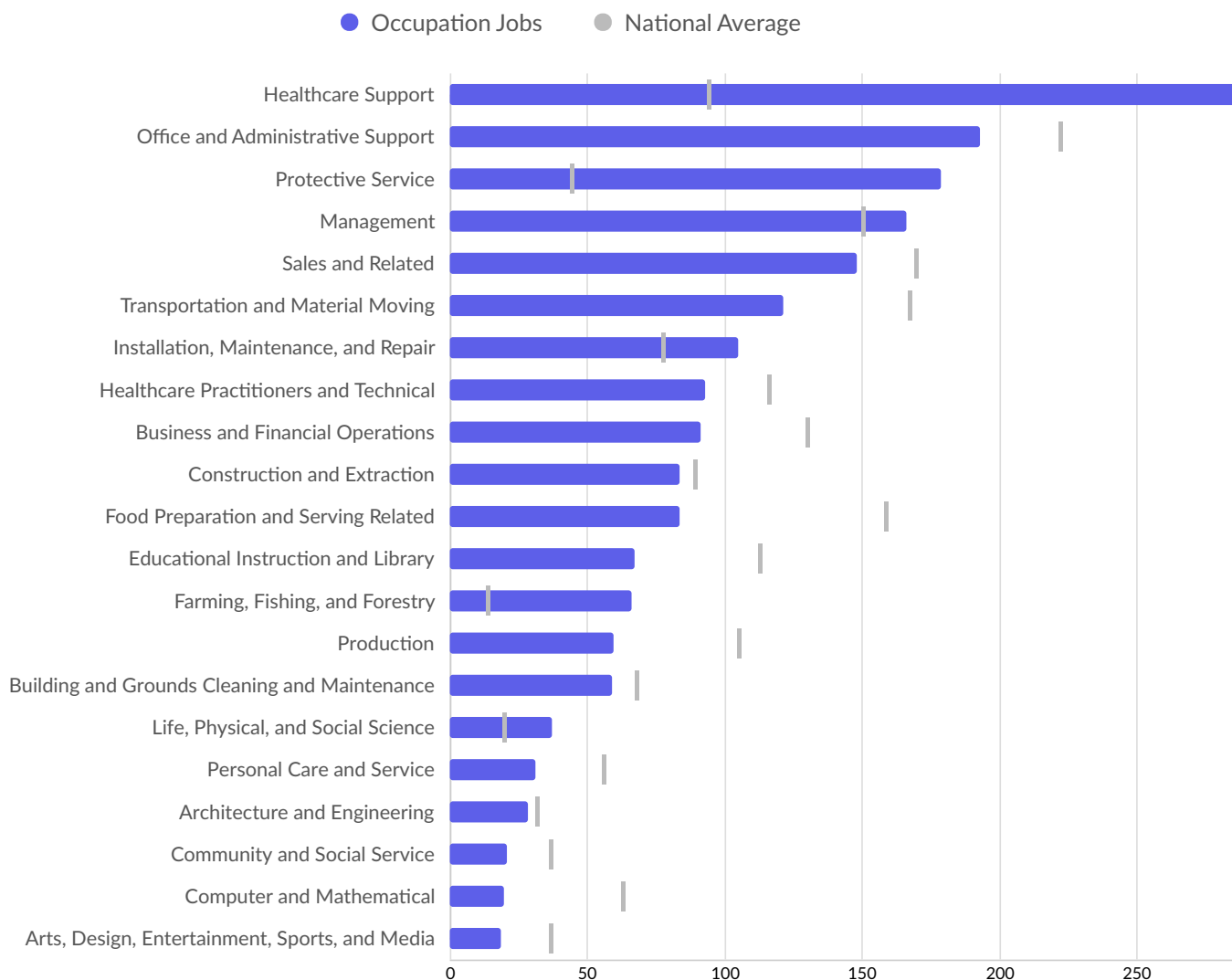

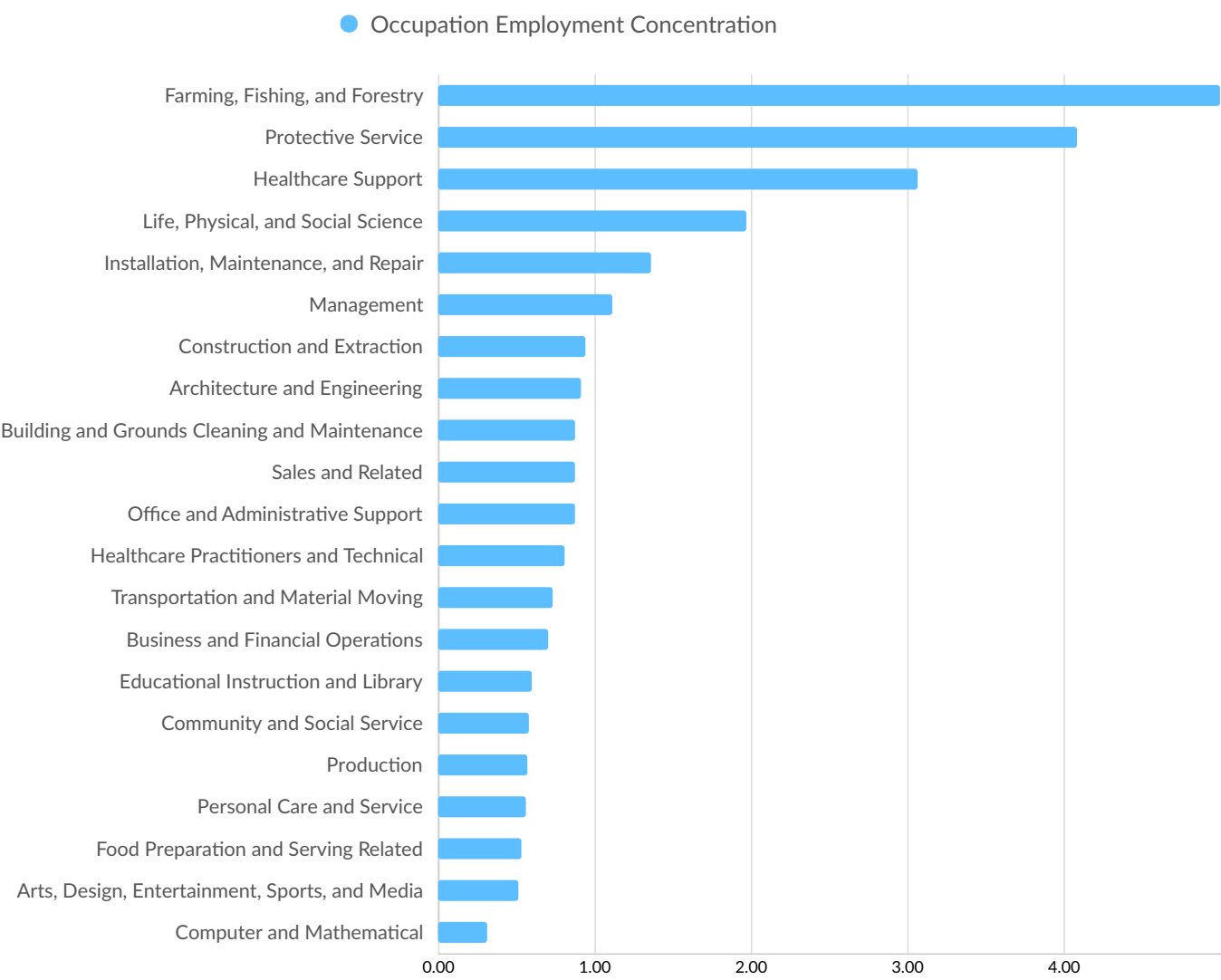

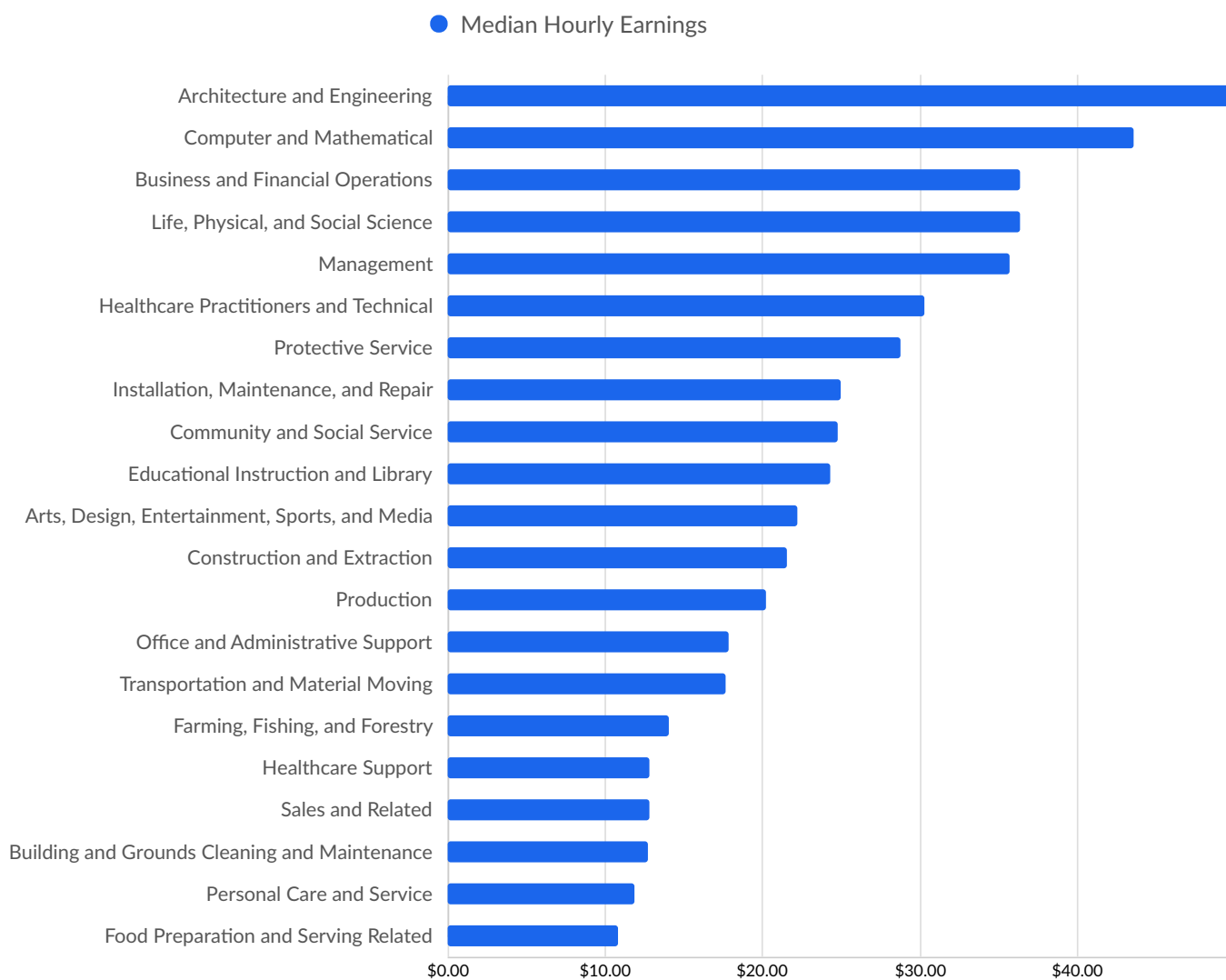
Top Growing Occupations



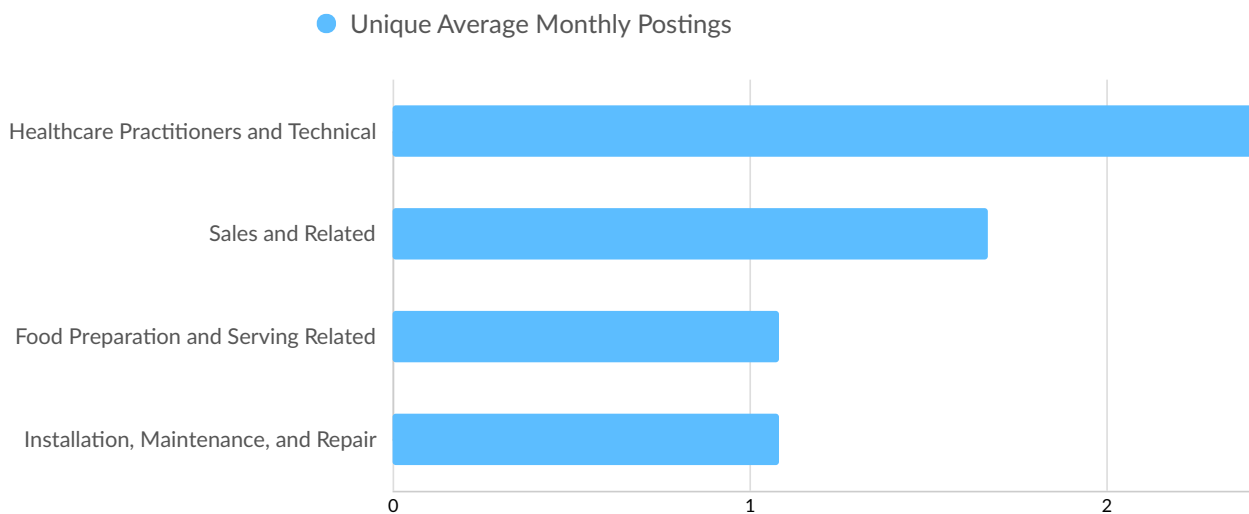
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



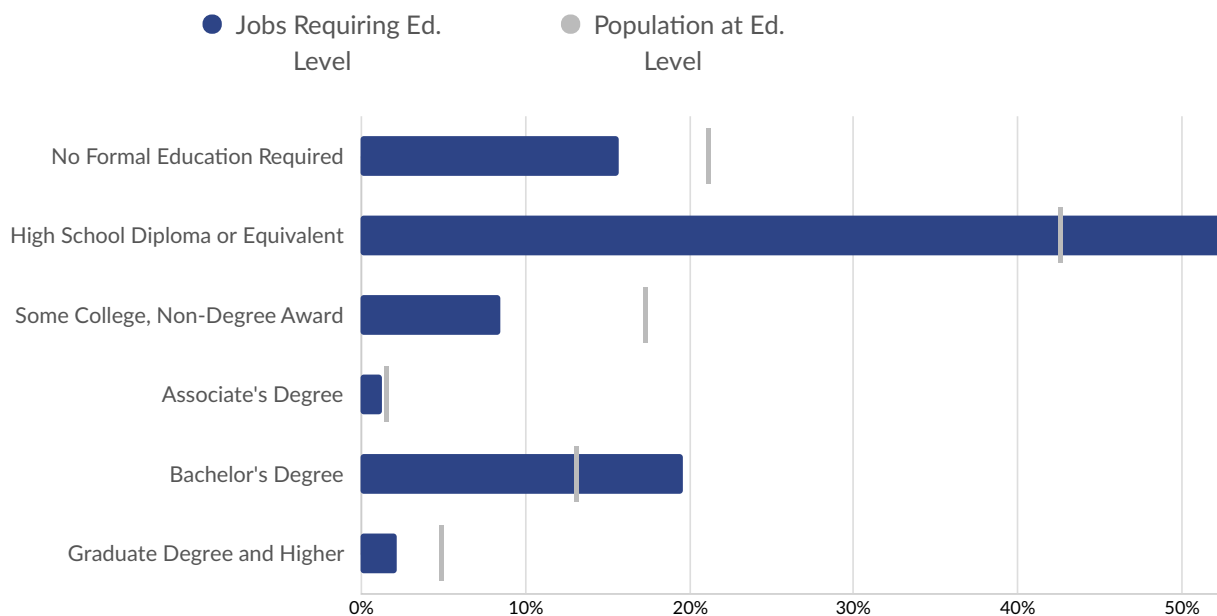
