- 1) Per job walk. Controls to be excluded from the bid. Controls contractor to be responsible for reconnecting wire and controls programming. Also, could you clarify if the controls contractor will be responsible for any new conduit.

Winning Bidder must ensure units are spec'd to accept Pelican controls. District designated vendor will complete install of such controls when needed. District vendor will be responsible for any infrastructure work needed.

- 2) Are structural upgrades to be excluded from the bid. Are structural upgrades will be addressed after the bid is awarded.

No structural upgrades are to be included. It should be a "like for like" replacement. Any structural upgrades will be addressed after the bid is awarded.

- 3) Per job walk, existing equipment/ductwork supports to remain

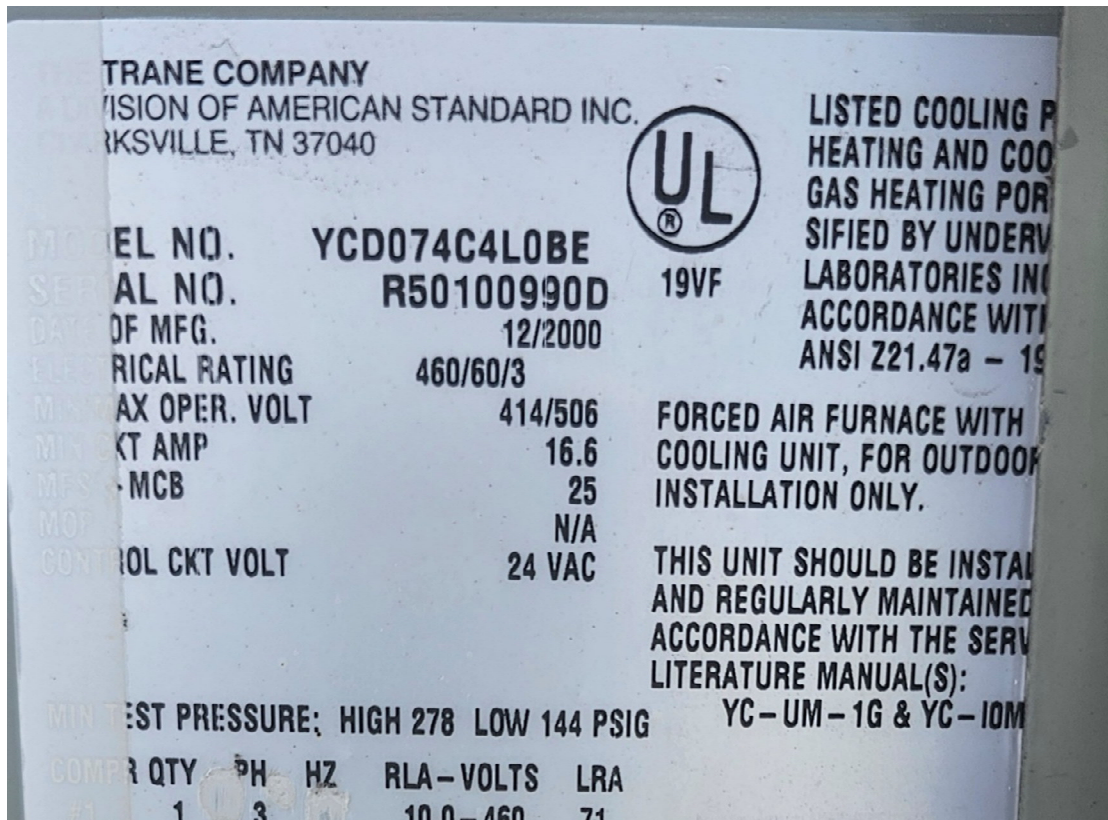

6. **Bid Bond.** For all Bids greater than \$75,000.00, the responding Contractor shall provide with its bid a certified or cashier's check or bidder's bond for an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount. The certified or cashier's check or bid bond shall be made payable to the order of the District. If a bid bond accompanies the bid/proposal, the bond shall be secured by an admitted surety company, licensed in the State of California, satisfactory to the District and in the form attached hereto. The certified or cashier's check or bond shall be given as a guarantee that Contractor will enter into the Contract if awarded the Work, and in the case of refusal or failure to enter into the Contract, the District shall have the right to award to another bidder. If Contractor fails or refuses to timely enter into the Contract, the District reserves the right to declare the bid bond forfeited and to pursue all other remedies in law or equity relating to such breach including, but not limited to, seeking recovery of damages for breach of contract. Failure to provide bid security, or bid security in the proper amount, will result in rejection of the bid.

7. **Noncollusion Declaration.** Contractor shall provide with its bid the Noncollusion Declaration in the form attached hereto.

8. **License.** Contractor certifies that it is, at the time of bidding, and shall be throughout the period of the Contract, licensed by the State of California to do the type of Work required under the terms of the Contract Documents. Contractor further certifies that it is regularly engaged in the general class and type of work called for in the Contract Documents.

9. **Prevailing Wages.** Pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code, Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall pay all workers on all work performed pursuant to the Contract not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the State of California Department of Industrial Relations ("DIR") for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District. Copies of the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the Contract, as determined by the DIR are on file and available from the District at the District's office or on the internet (<http://www.dir.ca.gov>). In addition, if awarded a contract, Contractor shall comply with Labor Code § 1777.5 pertaining to prevailing wage compensation to apprentices for preemployment activities.

10. **Contractor Registration.** Contractor shall ensure that it and its Subcontractors comply with the registration and compliance monitoring provisions of Labor Code section 1771.4, including furnishing its Certified Payroll Reports ("CPR") to the Labor Commissioner, and are registered pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. Contractor and its subcontractors shall comply with Labor Code section 1725.5 to be qualified to bid, be listed in a bid or proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code or engage in the performance of the Contract.

11. **Bid Protests.** Any bid protest by any Contractor regarding any other bid on this Project must be submitted in writing to the District to PATRICK BERNHARDT EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR BUSINESS SERVICES pbernhardt@lgsuhd.org at before **5:00 P.M.** of the **SECOND (2ND)** business day following the date of bid opening, or the Contractor waives its right to protest. The protest must contain a complete statement of any and all bases for the protest and the Contractor must concurrently transmit a copy of the protest to all other bidders that appear to have a reasonable prospect of receiving an award depending upon the outcome of the protest.
