Mandatory Practice

Friday, June 6th, 10am

- Seniors meet in in the new Fieldhouse with check-in beginning at 9:30am.
- Students must enter at Door 6 and park in the bus lot.
- Attendance will be taken.
- If student does not attend practice, they will not participate in graduation.
- Dress: Comfortable clothes, NO cap and gown.
- Students may want to consider wearing their commencement shoes during practice. This will allow them to turf test before the big day.

Sat, June 7, 2pm

12:30pm: Audience enters gates 1, 2, & 4
1pm: Students arrive at Door 6.
(Only graduates are allowed in the building)
1:35pm: Processional
2pm: Ceremony

Option C

Sat, June 7, 6pm

4:30pm: Audience enters gates 1, 2, & 4
5pm: Students arrive at Door 6.
(Only graduates are allowed in the building)
5:35pm: Processional
6pm: Ceremony

Option D

Sun, June 8, 2pm

12:30pm: Audience enters gates 1, 2, & 4
1pm: Students arrive at Door 6.
(Only graduates are allowed in the building)
1:35pm: Processional
2pm: Ceremony

Guest Info

- There is no "inside" option and there are no tickets.
- In all options, spectators should be in their seats no later than 30 minutes before the start of the ceremony as the gates will close and the processional will begin.
- The decision to postpone due to inclement weather will be made by 6:30am (A), 10:30am (B), 2:30pm (C).
- Students/parents will only be notified by phone/text/email IF the change is necessary.
